Five Planning Policies Buckland Suggested For Future Industry

Lead in a Buckland area should be set aside for future industrial use "in excess of projected needs," planning consultants have advised in reporting the fifth policy in guiding Manchester's development.

Reservation of land for future industrial use is required so that the town may "insure a good choice of site and to permit low-density industrial development."

The consultants, Planning and Renewal Associates, Inc., of Cambridge, Mass., said that a 100-acre minimum be designated for an industrial park in the area north of Rt. 15, south of the Toland Tropic and west of Rt. 15.

On Dec. 15, members of the Town Planning Commission and the Town Development Commission met to discuss proposals in the master plan for areas which will be added to the industrial zone.

After reviewing several areas in town, the prevailing feeling, as expressed through comments and questions brought up, seemed to indicate that Buckland area was favored.

Among other areas mentioned were those on both sides of the northern stretch of the Wilbur Cross Highway, a site off the eastern end of Spencer St., and an area off the west side of S.

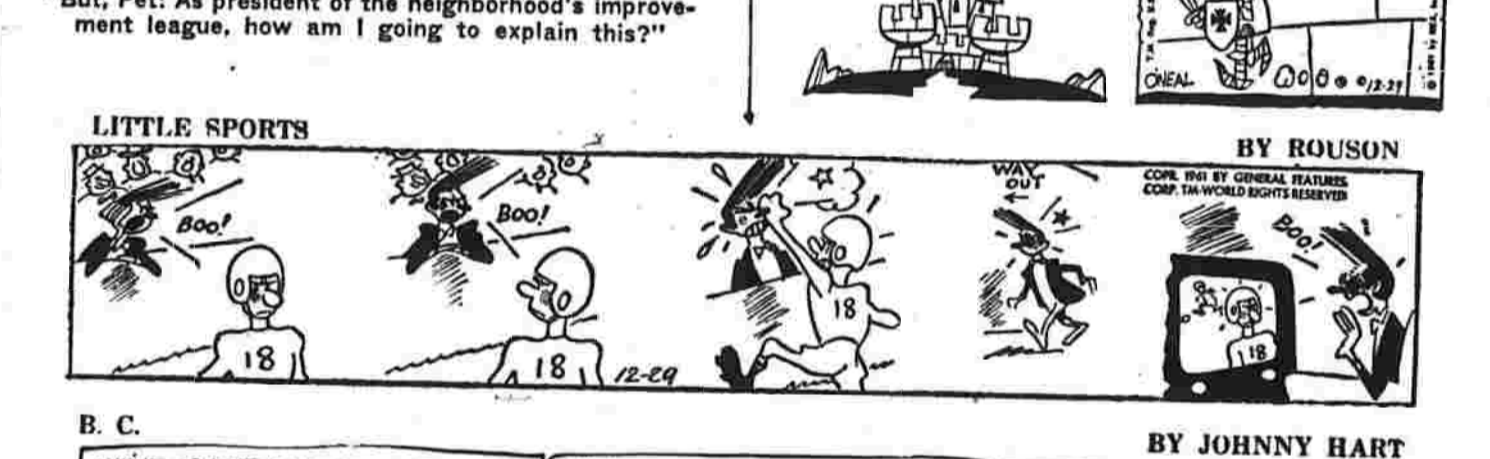
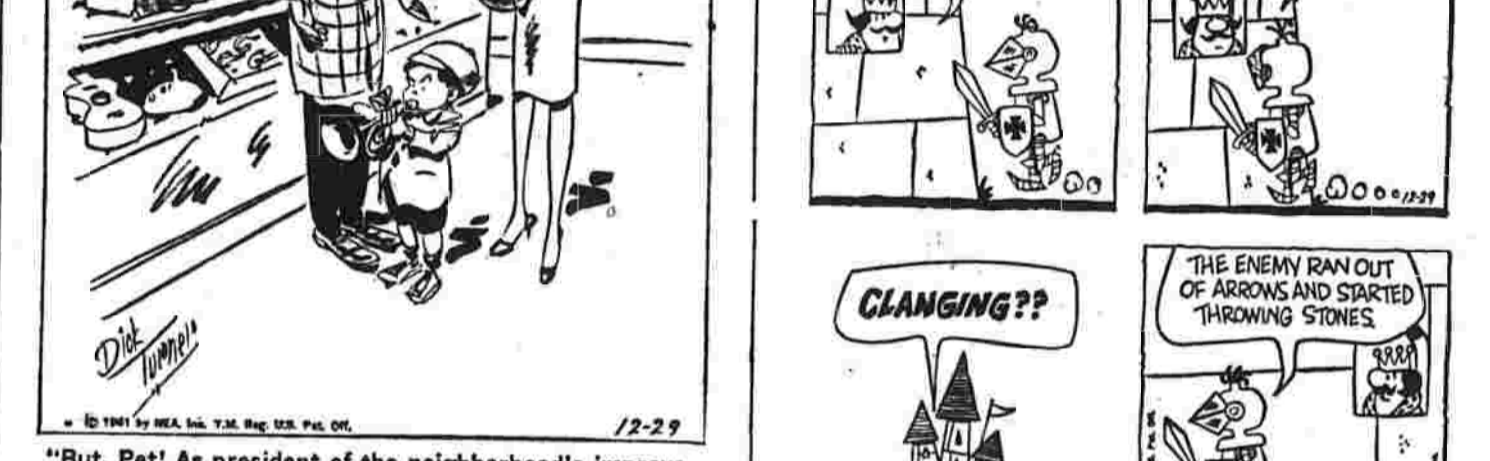
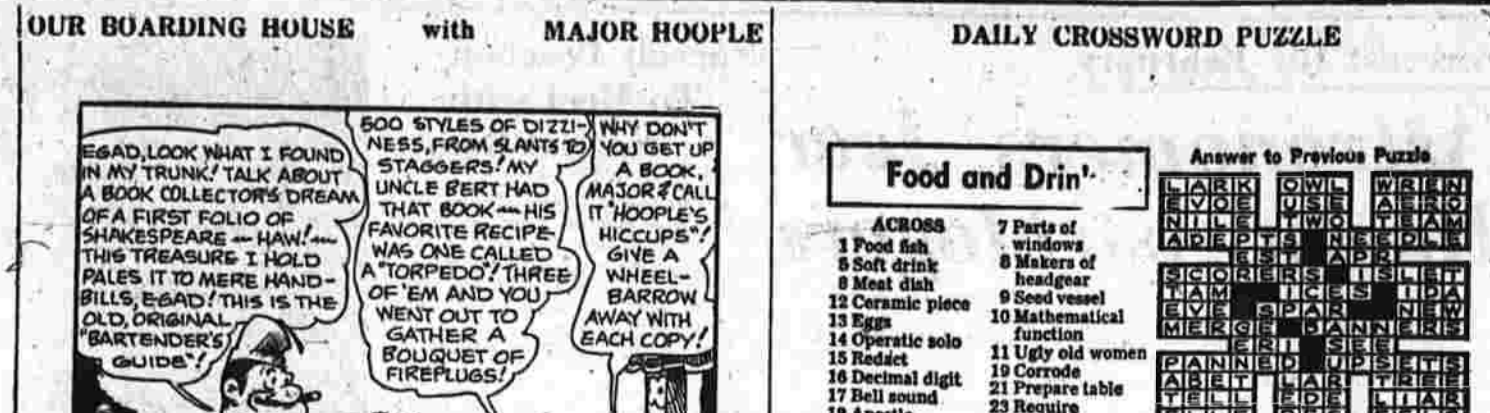
