Henry Fonda 'Special' Based on Statistics

Hollywood: A rival showman once said—with a marked tinge of jealousy in his voice—that Bud Yorkin and Norman Lear could take an ordinary restaurant menu and transform it into a smash television production.

Their latest effort, while not as far out as a restaurant menu, is to put it mildly, rather unique. It's an hour-long special that concerns itself with the love affair and mutual admiration society the average American family has developed over the years for statistics.

The unique presentation, which is hosted by Henry Fonda, comes off over the CBS network on the night of Feb. 6 and bears the appropriate title, "Henry Fonda and The Family."

"But," added Lear who prepared the script, "it's not Henry Fonda's family—that is, his son, Peter, and daughter Jane. It's a very talented cast of performers who we think represent the average family right down the line from grandmother to little brother."

In the all-star presentation are Dan Blocker, who is more familiar to viewers as "Hoss" on the "Bonanza" series; Carol Lynley, pretty blonde movie, TV and stage star; Dick Van Dyke, who is the comic star of his own TV program and Cara Williams, the vivacious red-haired star of television's "Pete and Gladys." Also featured are Verne Felton, Paul Lynde, Flip Mark and Michael J. Pollard. Bud Yorkin directed the production and composer David Rose and his orchestra provide the music.

"We think we've got an interesting show," Yorkin states. "You see, Americans are the most statisticized people in the world—and I have got the statistics to prove it."

Adds Lear: "We took these statistics as they apply to the average family and prepared skits—I guess you could call them that—

show, agrees with Yorkin and Lear, but doesn't think that the collection of such information about Americans will turn us into a super race of conformists who all do things because it's the thing to do—according to the statistical charts.

"Far from it," says the amiable Fonda. "I don't think the people are really affected by these statistics. I don't think we will lose our sense of individuality."

"For instance," he added, "if I were told that 62.3 per cent of men my age, height and complexion were left handed this wouldn't cause me to lie awake at night worrying because I'm right handed. My reaction would be—'Well, what do you know?' I could live through it."

Fonda agrees with Yorkin and Lear on the point that there is a reason for these statistics and that

they are important to someone. "Another for instance is the fact that we spent \$97 million on coffee last year," he said. "This is undoubtedly important to a coffee manufacturer or, perhaps a fellow who makes tea. Statistics also show us our national income last year was a record \$359 billion. That interests me because somewhere in that awesome pile of figures I am represented."

To prepare the show, Yorkin and Lear wrote to several government agencies in Washington to get statistical information. "And boy we really got it," grins Lear. "We are now on the mailing list of practically everybody in Washington."

Lear noted that teen-agers seem to be the ones statisticians show a special fondness for. One statistic they worked into one of their episodes on the show concerns teen-age marriages, and features

Carol Lynly, who portrays a teen-age wife who is pregnant.

"We discovered one-third of all 19-year-old girls are married," Yorkin said. "Carol is married in real life and she plays a pregnant girl in our show. Just by the greatest coincidence Carol is really pregnant herself. She should be having the baby just about the time the show airs. Perfect casting, I'd call it."

Dick Van Dyke plays a very senior citizen in one skit with Fonda. "I am 104 years old," Dick reports. "That is really long whisker territory. In another scene I show how you and you and you look to a television set. It's full of surprises, believe me."

Big and burly Dan Blocker is in one skit with Cara Williams who has a typically feminine craving to talk on the telephone. "And since females outnumber American males by 2,500,000—that's a bound to be a lot of talking," he adds.

Flame-haired Cara Williams comments that only Americans would get a kick out of laughing at themselves by gently spoofing the facts the pen and pencil boys collect about them.

"I think if you mentioned to an Englishman, for instance, that there are 30,000,000 women drivers on the streets today and 103,724 auto body repair shops, he might not get the point," Cara said. "But to the average American husband he feels there just aren't enough repair shops to go around."

Yorkin and Lear feel their production does not have a message of any sort—unless it's Americans can laugh at themselves.

When young Hollywood-bound Danny Belmont (Robert Ivers) hitches a ride into town with Kookie (Edward Byrnes) and ultimately winds up suspected of murder, the new "77" private eye defies the police in a solo attempt to solve the case. When he finds night club stripper Dolores Carlisle (Joan Tabor) in the beach home of the murder victim's husband, Kookie knows he is on the right track. Then dodging Lt. Gilmore (Byron Keith), who has a warrant for his arrest, and a gunman, who wants to kill him, become mere routine for the expatriating lot attendant as he wins his spurs as a sleuth in "Brass Ring Caper," a Warner Bros. "77 Sunset Strip" drama for the ABC-TV network Friday, Feb. 9.
