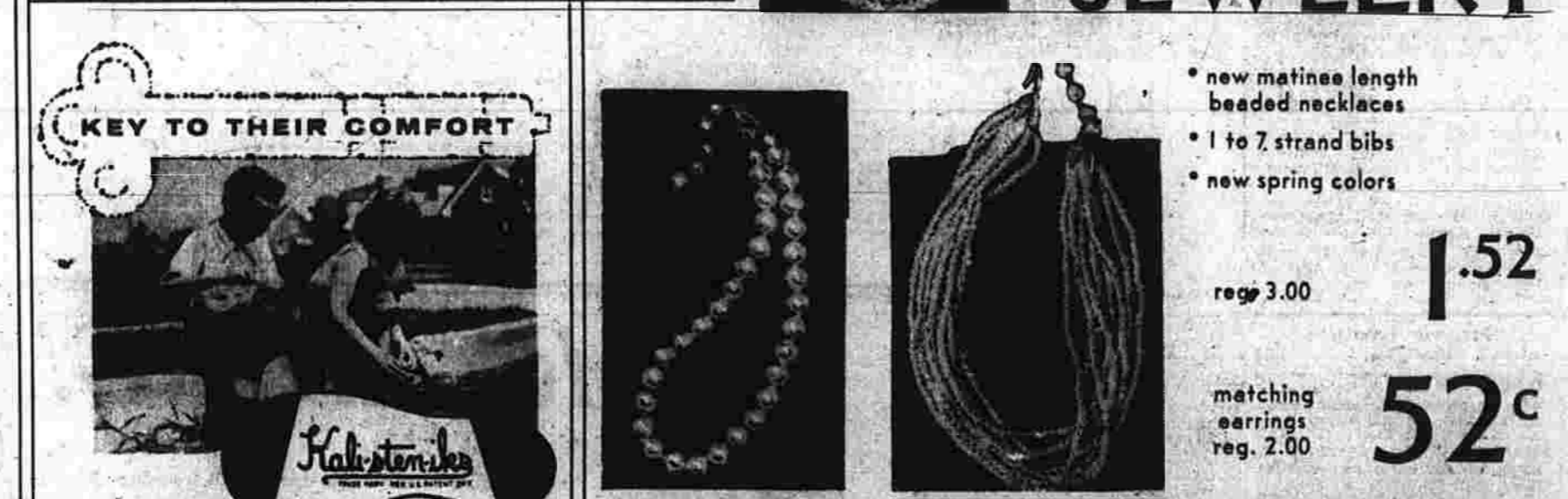

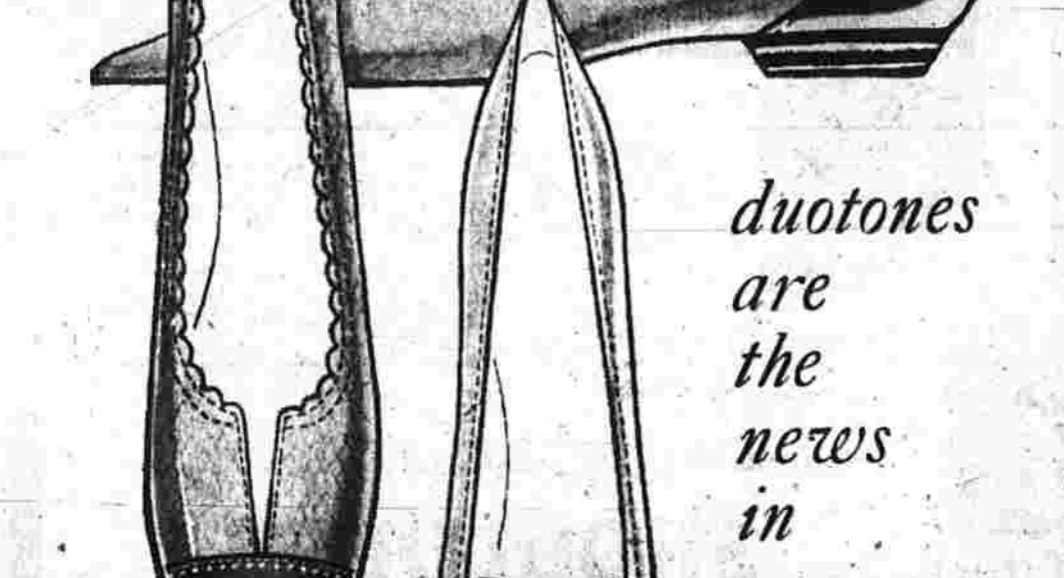

TV Personalities

Peter Hackes, NBC News Defense Department correspondent, has been at the Pentagon for eight years and can find his way around the sprawling structure as easily as around his own home. But this was not always the case. In fact, on his first day at the Pentagon, Hackes was convinced no one else could be less familiar with the vast building than he was. "My first assignment was to interview an admiral," Hackes recalls. "Well, I walked almost a mile to find his office, even though I had the exact room number. When I finally did find it, I discovered I had circled the building and that the admiral's office was just eight doors from where I had started."

Today Hackes wastes few steps in covering his beat, which includes regular attendance at briefings with the secretary of defense and high Army, Navy and Air Force officials; the National Aeronautics and Space Administration and other military and scientific assignments. Hackes, 37, began his broadcasting career as a news reporter for radio stations in Kentucky, Ohio, Iowa and New York. He joined NBC News in Washington in 1953, after four years with CBS, Washington.

For the past four years Hackes has conducted NBC Radio's early-morning "World News Roundup." His news reports are also heard on NBC Radio's "News on the Hour," "Emphasis," "Monitor" and "News of the World." On TV he has been a panelist on "Meet the Press" and "Ask Washington" and has reported on "Today."

Last summer, due to his familiarity with the nation's space program, Hackes was assigned to Cape Canaveral, Fla., as NBC Radio's anchorman to cover the flight of America's first astronaut and as NBC-TV anchorman for coverage of the second manned space flight.

Hackes was born in New York City and spent his childhood in suburban Pelham Manor. He holds a B.A. degree from Grinnell College, Iowa, and an M.A. in Journalism from the University of Iowa.

During World War II he served three years with the Navy and was discharged with the rank of Lieutenant (j.g.). Hackes lives in Washington with his wife, Mary Ellen, and their three children: Pamela, 8; Carol, 6; and Peter, 4. Hackes is a governor of the National Rocket Club and a member of the Radio-TV Correspondents Association, National Press Club, Aviation Space Writers Association, American Rocket Society and Sigma Delta Chi.

By DIK KLEINER, Newspaper Enterprise Assn. NEW YORK — (NEA) — The excitement generated by Col. John Glenn's flight should focus attention on television's role in making a popular hero. And, as a by-product, on television's place in the 1962 spectrum of entertainment media.

Television has the power to help make sudden heroes, just as it has been already demonstrated that it can go a long way toward making presidents. The only thing television can't make, apparently, is a major contribution to the arts. At this point, television executives ought to do a little serious thinking. When most people are asked what they remember as the high spots of their viewing careers, generally they mention certain memorable programs—the Kefauver or Army-McCarthy hearings, the political conventions, the Glenn flight.

Television in the medium best suited to documentaries, and we are building a great documentary tradition in American TV. When you think of the parade NBC White Paper, ABC Close-Up, The Twentieth Century, Chet Huntley Reporting, David Brinkley's Journal—it is encouraging. Over the years, these programs and others like them have contributed much to our knowledge of our present, to our understanding of our past, to our appreciation of our future. We have learned about space, about the right wing, about Red China, about psychiatry, about the White House, about an infinite variety of subjects. Some of these have been dull, a few alighted; happily only a small quantity have been really bad. By far the majority have been exciting, unbiased, factual, and they are made for television, and television is made for them.

More and more, TV should realize—and perhaps the Glenn flight will help that realization—that here is a form of entertainment that no other medium can touch.
