The agreement which Algeria will follow to become independent after 121 years of French rule.

It includes guarantees for the five million Europeans who live in Algeria with some nine million Moslems; establishment of a provisional government of French and Moslems to rule until independence after the self-determination vote; amnesty for Algerian nationalist prisoners; provision for France to retain military bases in Algeria; arrangements for a provisional police force and for gradual withdrawal of most of the 400,000 French troops in Algeria; and sharing of the Sahara oil and mineral wealth.

French troops fired on a Moslem mob in the west Algerian port of Arzew Monday, killing 11 and wounding 16. A 3 p.m. curfew was put on the town.

Twenty-five terrorist attacks or attempts in Algeria left 13 persons dead and 18 wounded.

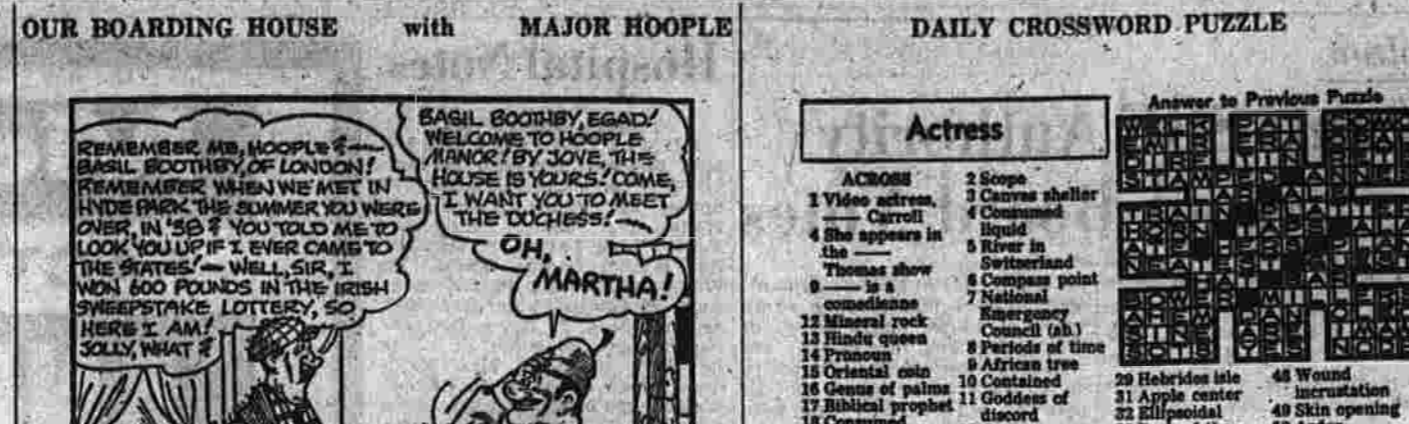

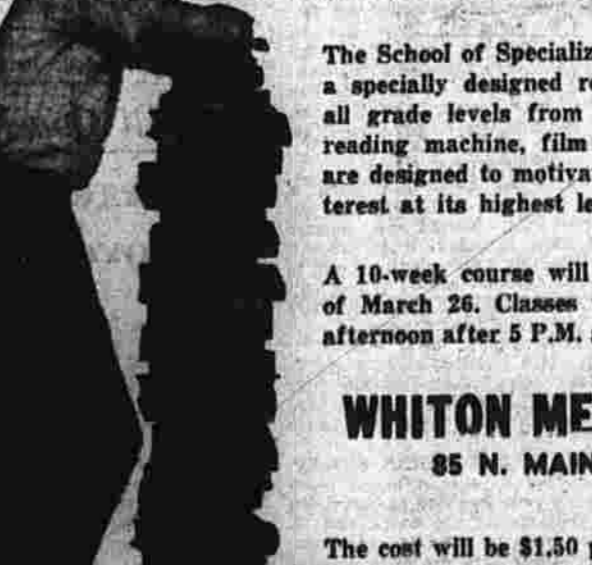

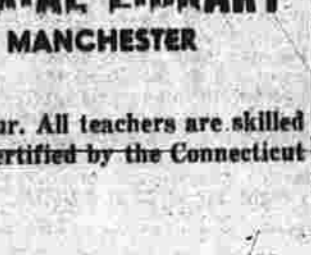
