Rusk on West Europe Trip To Mend Ties with Allies

Wide range of world problems to be covered not only in Paris but in London and Bonn. Rusk also will meet with the British prime minister, Harold Wilson, and other European leaders.

Rusk will depart for Washington early today. Rusk conceded there is "a moment" in the Atlantic community—the entering of "a new period of creative activity."

Rusk, calling the alliance's foundation solid, said his European talks will center on "what is next to be done—the new steps."

Rusk had a 90-minute conference in Berlin Monday with American Ambassador W. M. Alexander and British Ambassador Sir John Gorton. Rusk said he will be in Bonn for two days and then on to Paris.

This is another point of difference between Paris and Washington. De Gaulle feels these talks are a waste of time, and French administration believes it is important to keep the talks going—and the Kremlin agrees.

Whether Rusk will get to see the austere, unsmiling de Gaulle was not known for certain in protocol decisions of the French president to make and to announce.

Rusk, U.S. officials said, has no fixed agenda for his trip to any of the capitals. The issues, however, are well known, and he is ready to talk on any or all of them.

This is a country-by-country breakdown of the problems which will be taken up in the five capitals.

PARIS—The talks in the French capital will present the toughest problem for Rusk. The positions of Washington and Paris differ on such basic questions as negotiations with the Soviet Union in Berlin, on nuclear armament and the political integration of Europe.

All these headaches will be discussed in one way or another during the two days Rusk will spend in Paris.

The secretary, officials said, will restrict the talks to all of them, explaining that the talks with the Soviets have to go on, however fruitless the French may be. Rusk's effort here should be to help up the French position on the nuclear deterrent, and that Britain's membership in the European Common Market should not be held up by philosophical talks on the French future political ties among countries of Western Europe should be discussed.

BRUNN—While Rusk will likely give a unanimous opinion on the issue, whether he will discuss the Gaullist or his foreign minister, the situation in Bonn might be different.

Chancellor Konrad Adenauer is expected to continue to insist that the German foreign minister be more understanding at least in what Washington offers to do for the secretary. On the nuclear issue, the secretary will have a smooth sailing in Bonn, as the Germans are satisfied with the present structure with the United States and NATO's unilateral control over NATO's nuclear arms.

LONDON—There will be few if any controversial topics to be discussed in London. Rusk's talks will be more of a working conference, and he will discuss Britain's desire to join the Common Market. Rusk however, might question a British contribution to NATO's conventional forces in Europe, which the United States considers inadequate.

ROME—The day Rusk will spend in the Italian capital may be the most important of his trip. The United States is satisfied that through some filtration with the left Italy is a staunch partner in NATO. Rusk will be willing to listen to Italian ideas on how to solve problems in Africa and in the Middle East, and he will discuss the Italian claim to be more familiar than other members of the Western alliance.

LISBON—His short stop of two to three hours in Portugal, which Portugal probably won't be too pleased. Portugal is angry with the United States and NATO, that it was abandoned by its NATO allies when India invaded Goa, the Portuguese territory on the Asian peninsula.

Rusk will discuss the future of the U.S. bases in the Azores, vital in important in NATO and air communications with Europe. The rights to use them expire by the end of the year. The Portuguese government of Antonio Oliveira de Sa has given no indication if it will extend the rights.

Septic Tank System Possible On Brandy St. School Site

The public building commission (PBC) heard last night that it appears an adequate area is available for sewage disposal on the town's Brandy St. property so that a sand filter and piping of effluent to a brook will not be necessary.

In a memorandum from Architect Arnold Lawrence it was stated that 37 test holes were made at the site of the proposed secondary school and an area large enough for a septic tank and a sand filter was found. Lawrence estimated the resulting sewage at \$25,000 from previous cost estimates for sewage disposal facilities. In addition it will not be necessary to obtain easements from private property owners for piping the effluent from the school.

The area found to be suitable for the septic-tank-type of sewage disposal is roughly the rectangular area located toward the rear of the property.

In preliminary discussions, the architect, school Supt. Philip L. Lippert and members of the PBC talked about locations for the school and the piping of effluent to a natural amphitheater which would be ideal for an arena is located toward the back of the property.

A discussion of the area to be contained in the school developed that an area of 100 square feet would be better than the 41,000 square feet mentioned in the board of education specifications.

The sub-committee on planning and design of the PBC reported that T. Jack Crockett, chairman of the PBC, had drafted the architect's copy of the letter sent to the board of education by R. G. Alexander, P. A. J. J. and Dr. Alexander. Plans outlining specifications for a junior high school, Douglas Cheney said the P. A. J. J. letter was sent to Lawrence Monday for his information and so that it would be available at the meeting with the superintendent, architect and PBC members should they want it. The letter was not discussed and no action has been taken on it, Cheney said.

Harold Portherson, board of education representative to the PBC, asked if Crockett sent the letter on his own initiative or whether it was through action of the PBC. Cheney said that Crockett acted on his own responsibility and sent the specifications to Lawrence along with a letter stating that the P. A. J. J. letter was for reference only. Cheney said he thought more was being read into sending the P. A. J. J. letter to Lawrence than was intended, and that it was sent to be available at a meeting at which it was known that School Supt. Lippert was to be present.

Positive preliminary plans for the proposed school are expected to be ready for the PBC about June 28. If they are ready, a joint meeting of the board of education and the PBC may be arranged so they can see and discuss the tentative plans.

The PBC voted to request \$500 in its budget for the coming year, to cover the cost of the septic tank and piping of effluent to a brook for the present fiscal year.
