An annual report submitted by Thomas Monahan, building inspector, showed that licenses were issued for 119 one-family dwellings valued at \$1,091,840; 13 two-family dwellings valued at \$212,900; four apartment houses valued at \$143,000; 35 private garages valued at \$48,440; one church, Covenant Congregational, valued at \$114,270; three professional buildings valued at \$117,268; one bulk loading station valued at \$74,000; and 386 alterations and additions valued at \$1,056,247.

There were also licenses for a variety of other projects, such as a radio tower, seven swimming pools, a club house, three pumping stations, a gasoline station, 20 fences, and 41 signs.

The amount paid for fees for this construction was \$14,059.


