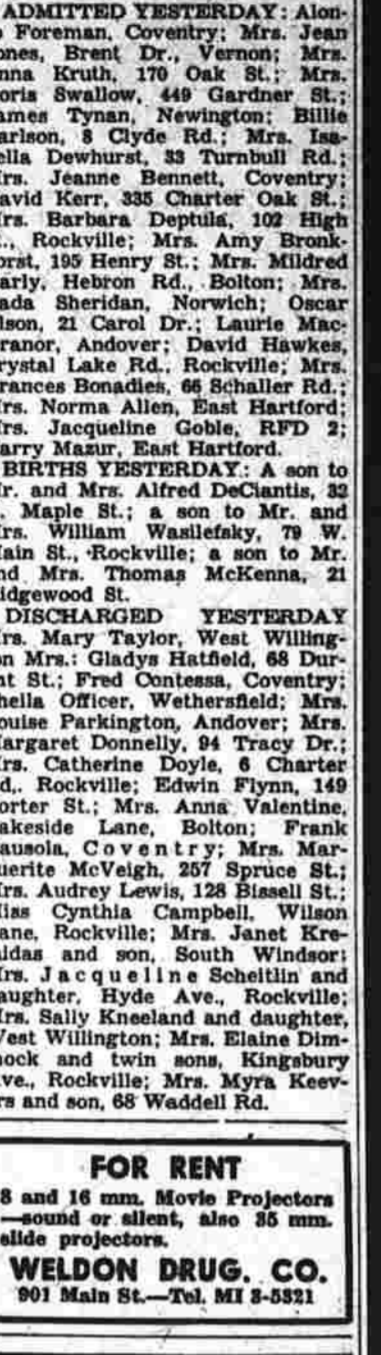

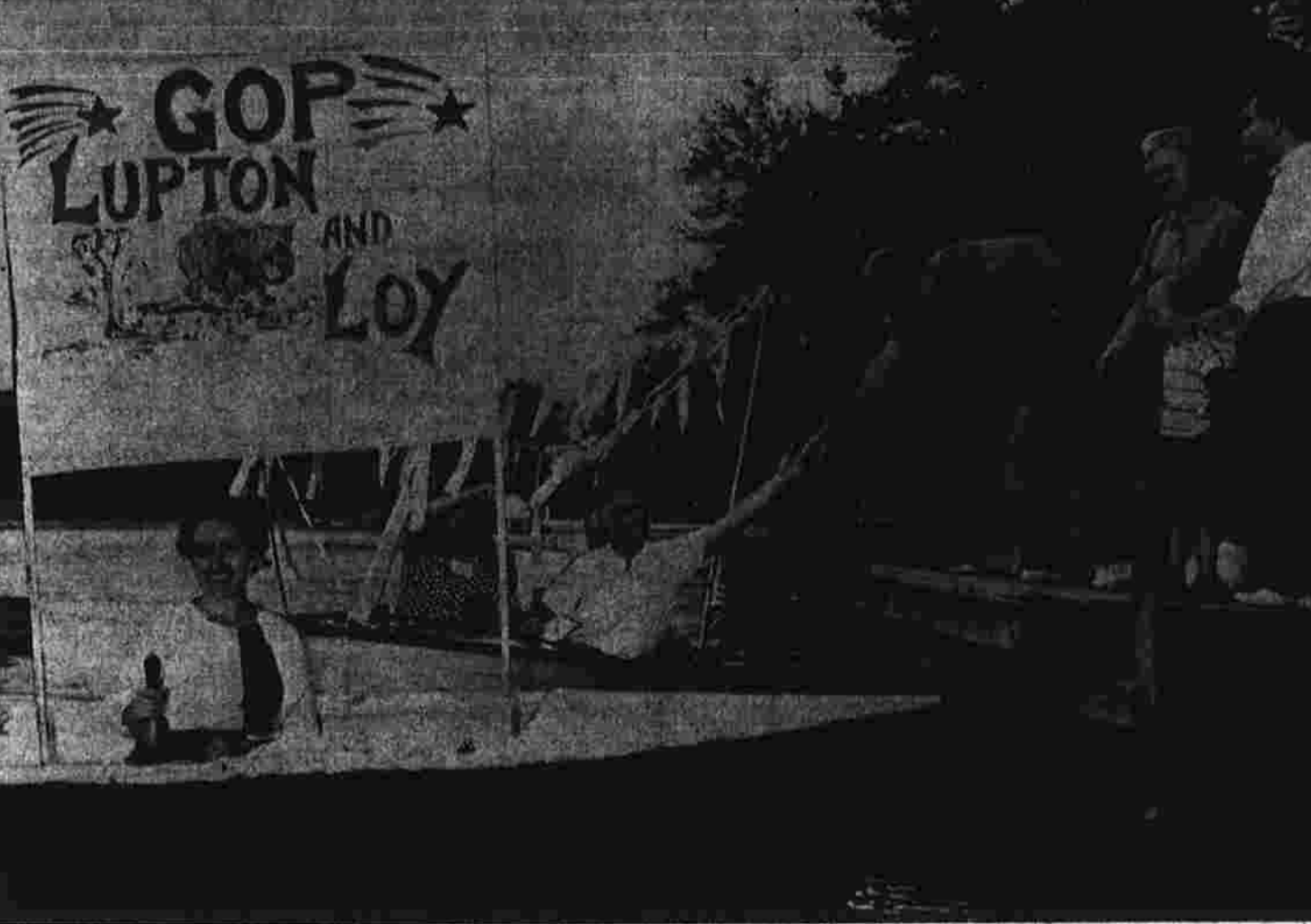

Work on Schoolhouse Described by House

(Ed. Note—In a letter to The Herald dated July 22, Manchester's Crossroads Arthur House, 150 Westland St., describes his work with other Operation Crossroads Africa students who are building a schoolhouse in Senegal.)

Having settled into a workday routine, we are now making some real progress. The work camp site, like so much of the soil in Senegal, is very sandy and dry, with only an occasional tree or bush to mark the arid, flat land.

We have dug the foundation for the school building and are now in the process of filling it with a rough cement made of seashells.

Another group is making bricks of cement for the walls. Next week, we will put together a prefabricated roof.

We are working with 12 Senegalese high school students. It is very difficult to get any of the university students to do any manual labor. Girls do not work with us because the social mores here prohibit girls from wearing slacks or working with boys.

Every day we commute to and from work together in the back of a truck, singing songs in English, Ouloff, and French.

We are divided into three work groups and each group tries to do its record of the day before. For example, the brickmakers yesterday broke their former record of 84 bricks in one day, while the foundation group laid 21 yards of cement. The Ministry of Youth and Sports has supplied us with shorts and shirts of a heavy blue khaki material. The shirts shield us from the sun and are heavy enough that they don't cling to the body when one perspires.

TV Personalities

Newspaper Enterprise Assn. NEW YORK (NEA) — President Kennedy advocates physical fitness, but he may have less effect on the condition than a moderate-sized blonde named Debbie Drake.

Miss Drake, she wears tight leotards and her physical fitness is obvious.

The knowledge that men watch her syndicated program, just to ogle, came as a complete surprise to her. She says:

"The program is directed to women and children. Do you know, I've been told hundreds of children learned how to count by watching the show? But men — I don't honestly know why they watch."

Since she has found out that they do, for one reason or another, she has set her commercially-acute mind to thinking. She's going to capitalize on the fact that she attracts male viewers by designing special exercises for them.

Debbie Drake is a Texas tomboy who reformed. As a child, she says, her mother used to worry that she wasn't feminine.

She says she still worries that she looks "too masculine" when she's doing her exercising. (Never fear, dear girl.)

When she was growing up, the extent of her ambition was to become a secretary. She achieved it. "But when I became a secretary," she says, "I realized that I didn't like it. I was sitting down so much that I was 15 pounds overweight. I was heavy in the hips and waist and skinny up above. So I went to a reducing salon and managed to lose 15 pounds and redistribute the remainder."

Her experiences with the salon were so mutually satisfactory that she stayed on as one of the staff. She has steadily kept her weight to a satisfactory 116 pounds ever since, "just right for her 5'5" frame."

She took the television plunge in 1959 in Dallas, appearing once a week for \$20. But she wasn't satisfied with her time spot, and jumped at a bid to do a daily program in Indianapolis for \$150 a week. She's been steadily increasing her popularity ever since.

Today she admits she could live comfortably on her television show (she's made some 260 15-minute programs, which are constantly circulating), her books and her merchandising (Debbie Drake leotards).

"But I want to be something else, too," she says, "echoing the cry of the unfulfilled down through the ages. 'I'll never give up the exercise business, but maybe I can do something in addition to it.'"

The something else? Acting. She's taken a small part in a summer stock production of "The Desk Set" as a starter, and will see what develops.

Meanwhile, of course, she continues to live an exemplary physical life. She must have nine or ten hours of sleep every night. She likes to spend an additional hour in the walking up process — "stretching while the body says, 'Good morning, world!'" — and she eats healthfully.

"My weakness in food," she says, "is what I call 'junk' — pastries and cakes. It's such a weakness that I won't allow any junk in the house."

Debbie Drake has given television something it hasn't had since the heyday of the low-cut panel show girls — healthy sex.

Hal Stanley, who will produce his first network series this fall, "Mr. Smith Goes to Washington," an ABC-TV Saturday night half-hour starring Fess Parker with Red Foley and Sandra Warner, first got the television bug when he produced a special, "The Lord Don't Play Favorites," back in 1957. Now in addition to his new TV series, he hopes to do that special as a Broadway play with the original star none other than Kay Starr. She, incidentally, is also his business partner. If the vehicle lands on Broadway, Stanley wants Louis Armstrong to share star billing. Miss Starr will also be seen on "Mr. Smith Goes to Washington," with present plans calling for her to essay a Perle Mesta type role. When asked to describe "Mr. Smith Goes to Washington," Stanley says: "It's a warm humor with heart, no big jokes." Instead of being a crusading solon as in the motion picture version, Fess Parker will be a grass roots politico championing the rights of little people.

ABC-TV's "The Flintstones" was voted a Golden Mike award as the "favorite program on television or radio" by the Junior Jury (under age 18), members of the American Legion Auxillary from 50 states.
