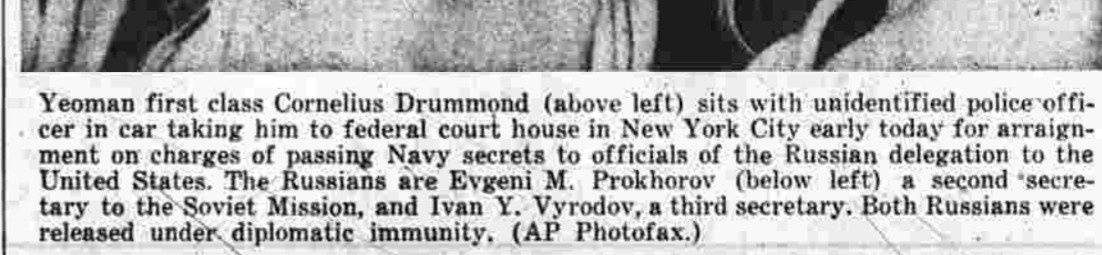

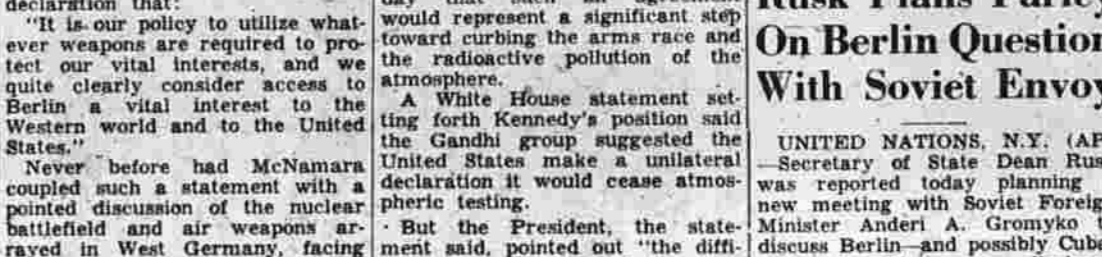

'Gallant Men' Series Starts Oct. 5 on ABC

HOLLYWOOD—Americans will see a new television series this fall that will bring back a lot of memories to a lot of people.

Its title is "The Gallant Men," and Warner Bros. is filming it for showing over the ABC-TV network, with the opening show airing Friday, Oct. 5.

The series deals with the adventures, dangers, hardships, laughs—and sometimes deaths—of members of an infantry company with the 5th Army in Italy during World War II.

Robert McQueeney—who has appeared in such Broadway productions as "Billy Budd," "Dial M For Murder," "Affairs of State" and "The Fragile Fox" He also has appeared in many Shakespearean plays, including the Helen Hayes production of "McBeth," in which he played the title role.

Richard X. Slattery—who has been featured in many TV shows, including "Armstrong Theatre," "TT Sunset Strip," "Bus Stop," "Sgt. Bilko" and two series emanating from New York, "The Verdict Is Yours" and "From These Roots," as well as summer stock and off-Broadway presentations.

Eddie Fontaine—who is a well-known singer and recording artist with a major hit record, "Rock Love," to his credit. He has sung in many night clubs and theatres as a headliner but turns to drama with "The Gallant Men." He portrays Pvt. D'Angelo, the outfit's wheeler-and-dealer.

Roland LaStarza—who was the No. 1 heavyweight boxing contender and fought Rocky Marciano for the title before he turned actor. He has studied acting at the Theatre Club in New York and appeared in a number of TV shows. He plays Pvt. Lascovich.

Robert Gothe—who studied at the Neighborhood Playhouse in New York and appeared in "Visit To A Small Planet" on Broadway, as well as in the road company of "Tea and Sympathy." He has numerous TV credits and appeared in several feature pictures, including "Kings Go Forth" and "Sanctuary." He plays Pvt. Hanson, Roland LaStarza's buddy.

Here is a synopsis of the show: It is September 1943. Conley Wright (Robert McQueeney), a distinguished war correspondent, braves heavy German fire to go ashore with the American and British armies at Salerno, Italy. Salerno and then Naples are captured.

Conley then moves with the American Army toward Rome. Immediate objective is the small but strategic town of San Pietro. Captain Benedict (William Reynolds), young commanding officer of the unit to which Conley is attached, is uncertain of his ability to command under fire.

Among his men are Jake (William Windom), Lt. Kimbro (Robert Ridgely), Sgt. McKenna (Richard X. Slattery), D'Angelo (Eddie Fontaine), Ernie (Roland LaStarza) and Sam (Robert Gothe). Benedict particularly relies on the judgment of Jake, a rugged private whom Conley recognizes as a major he knew in Casablanca.

Jake cracked under the strain of his command and has now taken on the identity of a private, who had been killed. Jake is desperately trying to redeem himself for the cowardice in action, Conley agrees not to reveal Jake's true identity.

The initial American assault on San Pietro in December has been repulsed with heavy casualties. Mount Lungo, scene of previous allied defeats, still remains the key to San Pietro. Tanks are unsuccessful in dislodging enemy positions. Jake points out it is a job for guts and bayonets.

At Jake's suggestion Captain Benedict gives the order for his men to move. Mount Lungo falls

after fierce fighting. It has been a costly battle, but the enemy withdraws from San Pietro. Jake is critically wounded, but not before he has redeemed himself as a hero. However, he begs Conley not to write the story of his heroism. "The Captain has won his spurs. Let him keep them," he says. The American soldiers are ready to move on toward Rome.

TV Personalities

Irene Ryan
A deadpan expression, an impassible voice and a supercharged talent have changed the bell of success for pike-faced Irene Ryan since the golden age of vaudeville.
Miss Ryan, who creates the role of Grannie on "The Beverly Hillsbillies" on the CBS Television Network, made her debut at the age of 11 when she won an amateur contest on a San Francisco stage.
Since then she has had a notable career as a headliner in vaudeville, radio, motion pictures, night clubs and television. She has built a reputation as a scene-stealer while belting out songs and swapping wisecracks with such stars as Rudy Vallee, Bob Hope, Jack Carson, Danny Thomas and Tennessee Ernie Ford.
Miss Ryan was born in El Paso, Tex., but moved at an early age to San Francisco. Before the ink was dry on her diploma from Fairmount School she was earning \$25 a week singing and dancing in the chorus of a stock-company show. She went on to become one of vaudeville's biggest stars.
From vaudeville she stepped into radio, appearing with Meredith Willson on "Carefree Carnival," which had its debut in San Francisco in 1932. This show led to appearances on numerous important programs, including "The Vallee, Carson and Hope show," and eventually to her own series, "The Tim and Irene Ryan Show."
Miss Ryan's success on radio was a springboard to a motion picture career as one of Hollywood's most sought-after character actresses.
On television she has starred on "Matinee Theatre" and guest starred on other programs.
Miss Ryan has traveled all over the world giving benefit performances, appearing at veterans' hospitals and co-starring with Bob Hope on his tours of military installations during World War II and the 1948 Berlin Airlift.
