Long News Famine Threatens in NYC

NEW YORK (AP)—Negotiations resumed today in a strike that has shut down daily newspapers in this city of eight million for two straight days. Chances of a quick settlement seemed slim. Both sides in the dispute—representatives of all nine metropolitan dailies and the striking printers' union—were called into session at the behest of the Federal Mediation and Conciliation Service.

Stephen I. Schlossberg, special assistant to the director of the service, said the publishers and unions were "pretty far apart." He said "we're always hopeful," but indicated he saw no signs of speedy agreement. "We will do whatever we can," he added. "We'll just have to see what develops."

Rocky Campaign Aims At Kennedy, Not Rivals

WASHINGTON (AP)—When Gov. Nelson Rockefeller cranks up his campaign for the 1964 Republican presidential nomination about five months from now, he intends to run against President Kennedy rather than potential GOP rivals. This strategy decision, reported by one of the New York governor's closest advisers, is based on what his advisers believe are the necessities of any effort to beat Kennedy, rather than overconfidence about obtaining the nomination.
