Sierra Leone, a member of the British Commonwealth of Nations, is issuing a series of 13 new stamps depicting various flowers found in the nation. The stamps are being issued in the west coast of Africa.

The name Sierra Leone was given to the country by a Portuguese adventurer, Pedro de Caceres, in 1482. He described it as "The Lion Mountains." Although it is principally an agricultural country, much of its wealth is derived from the production and export of iron ore and diamonds.

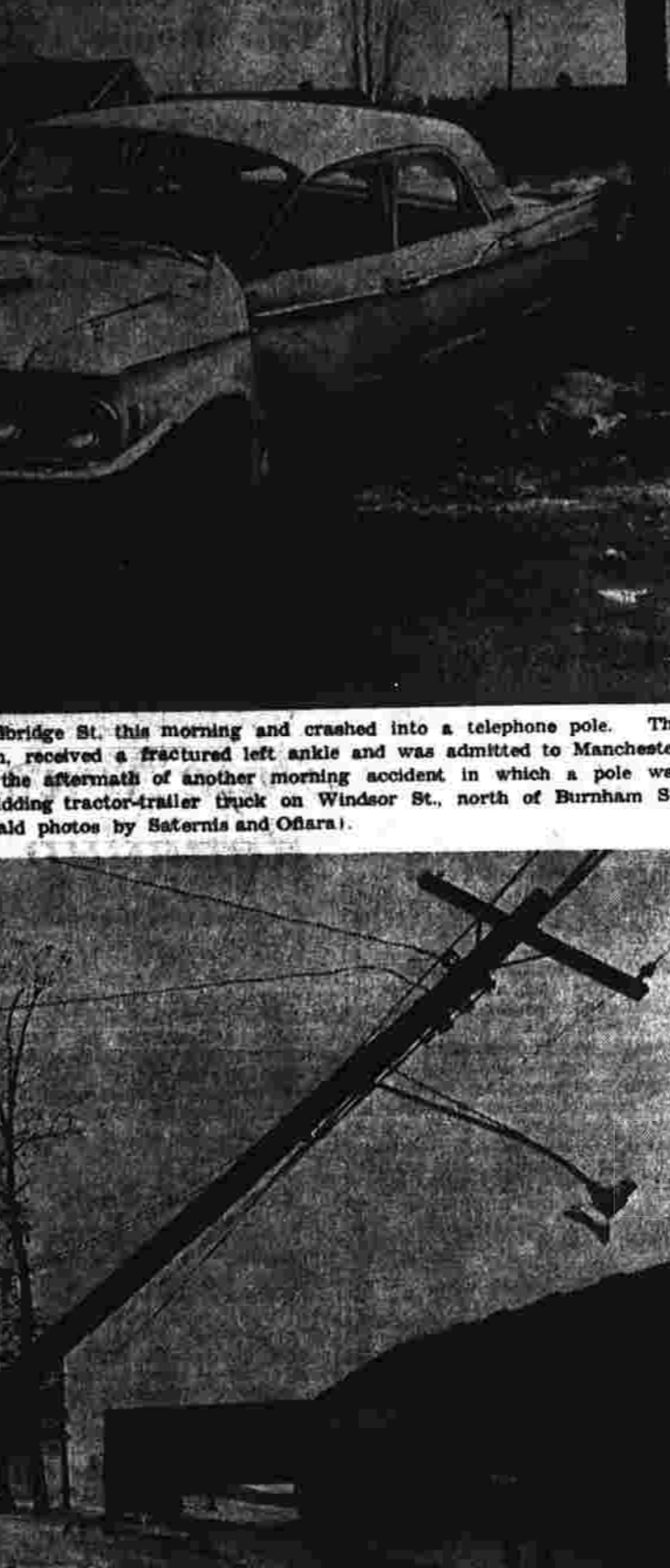
