Decrease Noted In Idle Claims Unemployment claims filed in Manchester last week totaled 1,897, a drop of 14, or 1.3 per cent, from those filed the previous week. In the state, as a whole, claims decreased by 493 to 43,464. For the comparable period last year, claims in the state rose to 49,282, including 6,441 federal extended claims, from 48,839, including 5,718 federal extended claims. The initial claims filed in Manchester amounted to 163, and continued claims to 1,048. Of the 1,211 unemployed women numbered 450, or 37.3 per cent. ### Fiscal Year, Capital Works Two School Budgets Adopted by Board

Two school budget proposals—a \$4,910,471 operating budget for the 1968-69 fiscal year and a four-year capital improvements budget totaling \$1,853,400—were unanimously adopted last night by the board of education.

The operating budget, \$4,910,471, represents an increase of 2.2 per cent over the current budget, representing about 32 tax mills at the present tax rate for education.

The 1968-69 year of the capital improvements budget calls for about \$250,000 in expenditures from the town's general fund, about an amount one-third of a mill, to pay for other school projects.

An additional \$1,287,400 in bonds is asked to provide for other capital improvements. However, the proposal must be approved by voters in a referendum.

The operating budget provides for 12 additional school personnel: three teachers at Manchester High School for science, social studies and art; three classroom teachers for elementary schools; three special education teachers in the art, music and physical education departments; and two guidance counselors.

The major increases are in the areas of instruction (mostly salaries), \$282,107; maintenance of plant, \$39,068; and fixed charges, \$20,070.

All areas of the budget were increased, the other increases being: Pupil transportation, \$16,150; community service, \$14,222; administration, \$6,887; operation of plant, \$6,711; health services, \$5,380; technical school, \$3,800; capital outlay, \$3,275; outgoing transfers, \$2,860; and attendance service, \$200.

Breakdown of the actual requests for each area are: Instruction, \$3,873,005; operation of school plant, \$331,812; maintenance of plant, \$114,722; health services, \$99,150; pupil transportation, \$96,400; fixed charges, \$47,200; capital outlay, \$33,086; community service, \$14,222; attendance service, \$3,800; technical school, \$3,800; and outgoing transfers, \$2,860.

The budget must be submitted to the General Manager Richard Martin by Feb. 21. The board of directors must approve the final budget by May 6.

The operating budget, about a one per cent increase over the current budget, includes \$4,250,422 in salaries, or \$7 per \$100 of \$60,040 in non-salary items, or 13 per cent.

The current budget is 88.2 per cent salaries and 11.8 per cent non-salary items.

The capital improvements budget will be submitted to the Town Planning Commission, and later to the board of directors. The school board wants the budget to be included in the town's capital improvements program.

The 1968-69 proposals the school board wants to be financed from the general fund include: Initiating an educational television system on a small scale, \$10,000.
