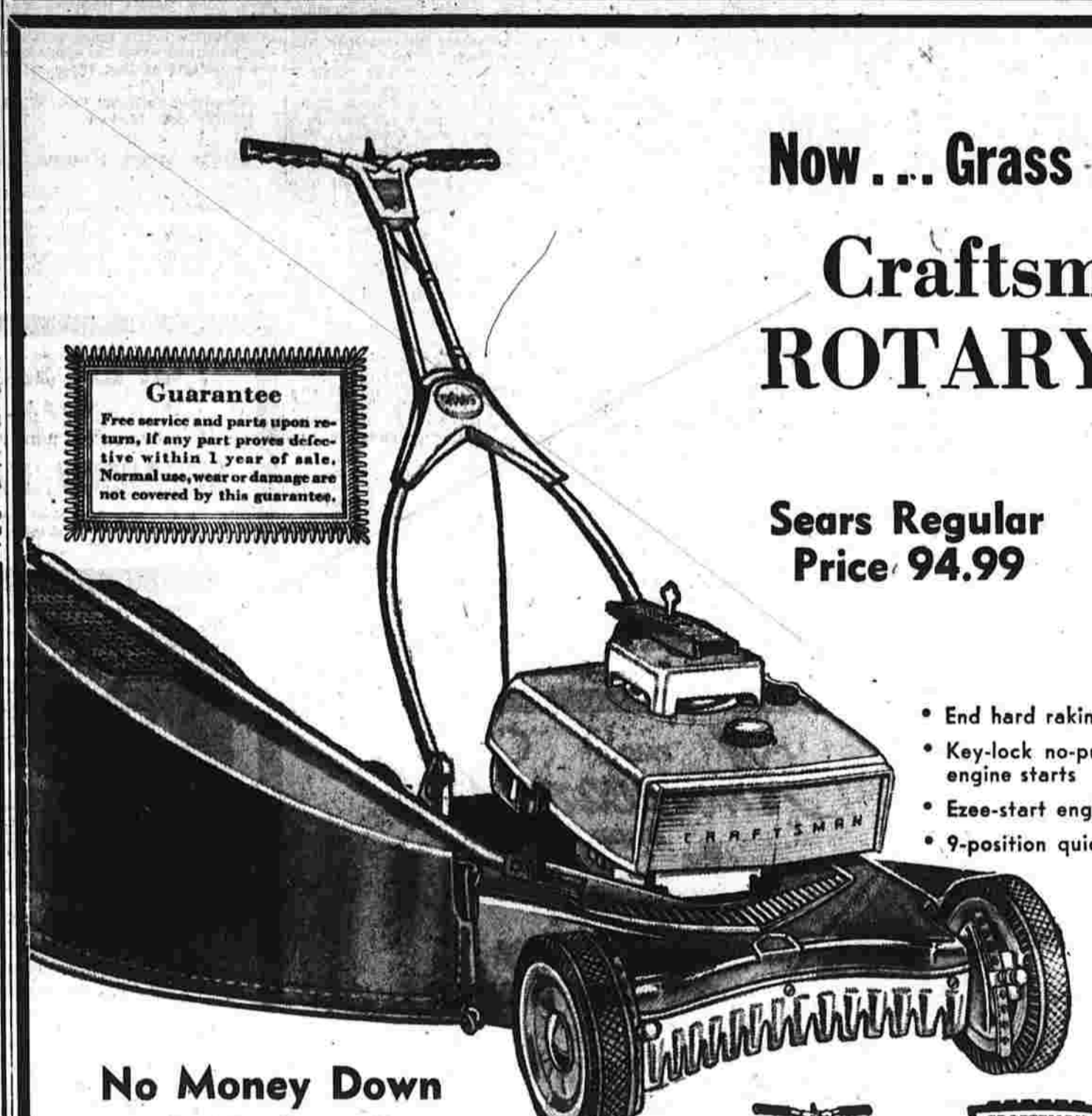
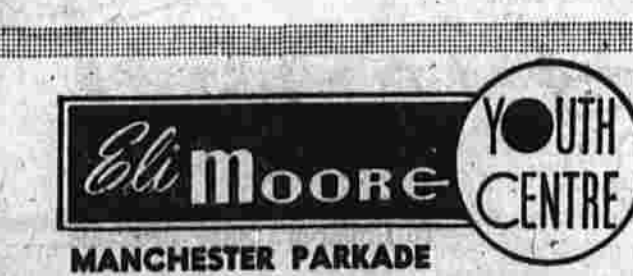

Berlin Economy Needs 15,000 Workers Yearly

By JOHN FEHIN. BERLIN (AP)—Keeping West Berlin alive and flourishing is a matter of constant concern for Western leaders. They speak of maintaining the city's viability in the face of Communist threats.

What the West Berliners fear is that the city will become a "ghost town" if the economy collapses. Experts estimate that West Berlin needs an annual injection of some 15,000 workers to remain economically viable.

West Berlin has a population of 2,175,000 and a labor force of 900,000. It lost almost 60,000 skilled workers overnight when the Communists closed the border and started building their wall Aug. 13, 1961.

These experts doubt, however, that the Communists will repeat the loss of workers caused by the interzonal trade agreement between East and West Germany.

#### The Doctor Says

**OUTLOOK TODAY IS FAVORABLE COLITIS VICTIMS**

Ulcerative colitis is a baffling disease. Its cause is unknown. It is easy to recognize and hard to treat. Although progress in treatment of this disease is being made, it still takes the lives of many children and young adults. The idea that it was caused by a germ or virus was held by some authorities, but has been abandoned, chiefly because there has never been an epidemic of the disease and it rarely attacks more than one member of a family.

There is some evidence that an emotional element plays a part in causing or aggravating the disease. Direct observation of the mucous membrane of the colon in a victim showed that anger or resentment is a cause of increased muscular activity of the wall of the colon, engorgement with blood, and small hemorrhages under the mucous lining.

For a long time, however, it has been believed that the stress and strain of the struggle in young people to become economically independent may be a factor. Recent studies strongly suggest that a severe allergy may be an important cause.

Whatever the cause, the ulcers that form in the colon and the resulting diarrhea rob the body of essential nourishment and lead to extreme loss of weight and weakness. Add to this a slow but steady drainage from affected areas and it can be readily seen that this is a serious disease; and, without proper treatment, it is a hopeless one.

Fortunately, much can be done for the victims.

Early in the course of the disease an attempt must always be made to control the process without operation. In many patients this can be done and, even when operation becomes necessary, the preliminary medical treatment puts the victim in a much better condition to withstand the operation. Rest, avoidance of emotional upsets, and a diet of soft roughage are the basic requirements. Blood transfusions may have to be given.

Medicated enemas have been tried, but have been abandoned because they further irritate an already damaged bowel. Psychotherapy has also been found to be of little if any value in treatment of persons with ulcerative colitis.

Cortisone and related drugs are used for about a year before, especially in preparation for operation. In patients with a severe initial attack these, drugs may be lifesaving. In those victims whose disease was found to be due to allergy, eliminating the offending food from the diet was attended after several weeks by marked improvement, but not by a permanent cure. A recent study in England indicates that a new salt drug (sulfasalazine), will control a mild attack, if given early in the course of the disease.

Even with the best of medical treatment between 35 and 64 per cent of the victims have to be operated on, usually from three to six years after the onset. If an operation is decided on, nothing short of removal of the diseased colon will help. This means that the patient will have a new opening, an ileostomy, in the abdomen. The ileostomy bag that he must wear has been so vastly improved in recent years that this is no longer considered a handicap.

I will have more to say about the growing band of cheerful ileostomy patients. Suffice it may at this point that, usually, the patient can do very well without it if we have to.

And what steps are the French considering to solve the problem? Well, the French are talking about establishing marriage counselor bureaus in various sections of Paris and in the larger provincial cities to help young couples get off on the right foot matrimonially.

That might be some help. But the only real and sensible answer to the problem of too-surely marriages is for parents to discourage their kids before they are placed. Can they do it? Of course they can. They can put an end to early dating, going steady in high school, setting their teenagers get the idea they can do anything they please because "all the other kids can."

But, most important of all, parents can impress their teenagers with the fact that once they marry they are completely on their own.

Sixteen-year-olds who marry today conditionally assume that their parents will give financial support to such marriages. They also help some that when the real help comes along, they can palm him off on one of their mothers if the wife needs to work — or at least they can count on their parents' keeping the baby in the evening so they can get out and have fun.

In short, what they want is to play house — with parents obligingly saying, "Don't worry, children, we'll see you through this."

Marriage wouldn't look nearly so inviting to kids who are old enough to be self-supporting and self-reliant if they knew that marriage meant standing on their own feet right from the start.

Artist Charged With Obscenity In Riot Pictures

OXFORD, Miss. (AP)—A teacher-artist whose paintings stirred up a controversy at the University of Mississippi is free today under a \$200 bond following his arrest on a complaint filed by a law student.

Justice of the Peace W.H. Jones said he would try the teacher, G. Ray Kerouac, 29, on May 3 on charges of exhibiting obscene and indecent paintings and desecrating the Confederate flag.

"I feel like a writer who has had three copy pages taken out of the middle of a book and blown so out of proportion the rest of the book is overlooked," Kerouac, a native of Detroit, said Tuesday before his arrest.

He faces a possible six-month jail sentence and a \$200 fine if convicted on the obscenity charge, and a possible 30-day sentence and \$100 fine if convicted on the other count.

Five of Kerouac's paintings, ordered removed last week from an exhibition of more than 100 of his works at the university, depicted his impressions of the desegregation riots on campus last fall. A reproduction of the Confederate flag was used as a background in each painting.

Charles G. Blackwell, 24, of Ellettsville, Miss., obtained a warrant Monday for Kerouac's arrest. Blackwell is a former state chairman of the ultra-conservative Patriotic American Youth Organization and a member of the Oxford-Miss chapter of the pro-segregation Citizens Council.

Gruber Piano Soloist For Orchestra Concert

John Gruber, Herald columnist and critic, will appear in dual capacity during the concert by the Manchester Civic Orchestra Wednesday, April 17, at Bailey Auditorium.

He is the regular conductor of the organization, and will wield the baton during most of the concert, but he will likewise be heard in the solo portions of the MacDowell Piano Concerto No. 2 during the performance of which John Healey, conductor of UConn's Symphony Orchestra, will lead the local organization.

The MacDowell concerto will be but one number in a program devoted entirely to the works of American composers. It is a work for virtuosic pianist and orchestra and Mr. Gruber's performance of the composition is particularly definitive.

He first played the work under the baton of George Whitefield Chadwick, who had conducted the American premiere of the concerto with the composer himself as soloist. A year or so later, Mr. Gruber won the MacDowell competition in New York and was complimented for his performance of the work by the composer's widow, who was likewise a pianist. Judges were all specialists in MacDowell's works.

It was about that time, too, that Martha Powell Betts, decided Mr. Gruber should be the subject of one of her many caricatures of musicians. She made a specialty of the profession and had previously done such notables as Stokowski, Toscanini and Heifetz. Her best known caricature, of the Boston Symphony Orchestra, raised over \$10,000 for the organization's pension fund.

The caricature of Mr. Gruber, reproduced here, was done during a recent visit to Boston's famous Jordan Hill, a few weeks after he had won the MacDowell competition.

Mr. Gruber will not be the only soloist on the program. Earlier on the program, Nancy Turzsky, first finalist of the orchestra, will be featured in the Poem for Flute

and Orchestra, by Charles Griffes. Three new compositions, to be played for the first time anywhere, will also highlight the program, which will close with two symphonic sketches by Chadwick, the same gentleman under whom Mr. Gruber first played the concerto.

One of these is titled "Noel," but its name has a different significance from what might be expected. Chadwick's first son was born on Christmas Day and was named Noel. He died in infancy, and the composition is as much a

memorial to the child as it is an evocation of the Christmas spirit. The other Chadwick number bears the title "Jubilee." A brilliant composition, it demands an excellent orchestra, and is the most difficult work from a technical viewpoint that the Civic Orchestra has ever attempted. Tickets are now on sale at Ray Beller's Music Shop on Main St. They may be had from any member of the orchestra, and will be available at the door on the night of the concert.
