

You Should Know . . .

Beldon H. Schaffer

In his approach to municipal questions with which he has been involved only since last November, Beldon H. Schaffer is most unlike a freshman in Manchester government.

Shortly after becoming a new member of the board of education six months ago, he was appointed by Mrs. Katherine D. Bourne, chairman, as head of the board's finance committee, which prepares the annual school budget.

Last month, he was appointed by the board of directors as a member of the new character revision commission. At its first meeting March 20, the commission elected him as vice chairman.

The 38-year-old Democrat is not unfamiliar with government. He was West Hartford's first director of finance, serving from 1950-51 after a reorganization of that town's municipal setup.

While he is new to Manchester politics, Schaffer's experience in West Hartford and his vocation bring him closer than many town officials to the theories and practicalities of local and state government.

He is director of the Institute of Public Service at the University of Connecticut, a part of the division of continuing education services.

The institute has "the largest course with public officials of any organization in the state," he says.

Being together, administratively, all organizations engaged in adult education," says Schaffer. The institute sponsors eight conferences yearly for state and local government personnel, he says.

Can Them All
 We have no particular resentment against any particular television audience or magazine readership rating service, not knowing enough about them to be able to sustain a particular attitude. And we have no disposition to quarrel with the usual comment which comes from one of these rating services when some client drops its services—said comment usually being to the effect that the particular client was probably up because his ratings had begun to go down in the reports from the service.
 Our point is that we are delighted to hear of any development which would result in a more accurate rating service contract—whichever tends to free this nation from the psychology of the rating survey.
 Even if these audience surveys were good, and completely expert, and would like them in fact, they wouldn't like them. It is the better they would be the more of a curse they would be.
 We have every intimation that they may be human, and therefore subject to error.
 There is a possible error, and in their possible loss of influence, lies hope.
