Fuel Blast Sign Seen in Crash. WASHINGTON (AP)—The Civil Aeronautics Board said today there is evidence of a fuel-air mixture explosion in the left wing of a four-engine jet airplane that crashed Sunday night near Elkhart, Ind. The CAB said there is other evidence that the left wing tip of the Boeing 707 aircraft was struck by lightning. Eighty-one persons were killed in the crash of the Pan American World Airways plane. The physical evidence of the fuel-air mixture explosion was in the form of wreckage deformation in the area of the left wing fuel tank. The CAB said that the airplane had probably been struck by lightning. The CAB said it planned to hold a public hearing on the crash in February on the air disaster.

Here are some of the people being given close attention:

Adlai E. Stevenson—The Democratic presidential nominee, and admired by many for his work as U.S. ambassador to the United Nations. He has large reserves of political strength, especially among liberal intellectuals in the largest states, California and New York. Critics question his executive decisiveness, call him a perfectionist.

Robert F. Kennedy—The attorney general would lend the magic of THE Kennedy name to the campaign by the North. But what would it do to the ticket in the South, where Robert has been even less revered among many white segregationists and "white" rightists than his late brother?

Hubert H. Humphrey—The whirlwind ex-patron from Minnesota, whom John F. Kennedy defeated early in the 1960 quest for delegates, has built up an enduring reputation among Northern liberals as a man where he is Democratic who has won the respect though not often the agreement of many Southern conservatives.

Rogers J. McCarthy—This liberal Democrat, junior senator from Humphrey's state, is a former professor of sociology and economics, a farmer writer. He served five terms in the House before winning a Senate seat in 1962.

Sargent Shriver—personable, expressive, brother-in-law of the late President Kennedy. A specialist in private life in real estate management, he took hold of the Peace Corps at its inception and—against betting that it would turn out to be a dog-eat-dog business—helped win it wide respect.

Edmond S. Muskie—the tall son of a Polish immigrant tailor played a leading role in re-organizing the Democratic party in Maine. One result: Two terms for him as governor and then, in 1962, he became the first Democrat ever elected senator by popular vote in Maine.

Edmond G. Brown—this vote-getting governor of California

active in the civil rights struggle, and also is thinking about possible education.

Oswald's Widow Drops from Sight

EDITOR'S NOTE: What has happened to Mrs. Marina Oswald, the widow of the man accused of assassinating President John F. Kennedy? After appearing in the newspapers for several days, she has been dropped from the news.

By JAMES MANGAN DALLAS, Tex. (AP)—She is a somewhat bewildered young woman, "temperamental" over the tragic slaying of President John F. Kennedy, but gallant in her resolve to create a future for her children in America.

That picture of Marina Oswald emerges from interviews with persons in close contact with her since she was widowed on Nov. 24. Her husband, Lee Harvey Oswald, was slain before he could be brought to trial as the accused assassin of the president.

Mrs. Oswald, 22, a native of Russia who has been in the United States less than two years, was sealed off by the Secret Service immediately after her husband's funeral.

The blonde widow appeared stunned by the collapse of her quiet life in the Dallas suburb of Irving. Pictures taken at that time showed her hugging her baby tightly, with a withdrawn expression on her face.

Now, almost three weeks later, she still has not given way to any overt emotional reaction, her advisers say. She seldom talks about her husband, but appears to feel his apparent guilt also is hers.

Her children are her life. She is described as completely devoted to the two girls—June, 2, and Rachel, 7 weeks. The family is living at an undisclosed location in the suburban Dallas area under a protective Secret Service guard.

This week, she was sent to Parkland Hospital—the hospital where Kennedy and her husband died—to get a postnatal six-week checkup, she was pronounced in excellent health.

Last week she was taken to a Dallas shop to buy a pair of shoes. She prefers to remain indoors. She spends a lot of time sewing.

She is said to be extremely eager to cast off her Russian name and wants to learn to read, write and speak good English. With the aid of a Russian-English dictionary, she tries to decipher the daily newspapers, and does a good job of it.

The outpouring of money and sympathy from the United States and the rest of the world has overwhelmed her. So far, she has received more than 1,000 letters, along with donations that have passed the \$12,000 mark.

Argentina Asks Custody of Peron

MADRID, Spain (AP)—The Argentine government has asked Spain to extradite Juan D. Peron to face a charge of seducing the girl who raised his two young sons.

Peron, 68, who recently moved into a luxurious Madrid residence with the former secretary he married after his overthrow in September, 1955, was not available for comment. A member of his staff said this is an old matter which has been brought up from time to time. It is absurd.

The Argentine ambassador, Gen. Julio A. Lagan, delivered the extradition petition to the Spanish Foreign Ministry Thursday.

A ministry source said the petition would be referred first to the justice ministry and then to a Spanish judge for recommendations. Generalissimo Franco's cabinet will make the final decision.

Spanish Foreign Office sources said there was no necessity to detain Peron in the meantime. The military government that took over after Peron's overthrow charged Peron with statutory rape based on his relationship with Nelly Riva.

Nelly, a shapely, wide-eyed brunette, said once she was "the only one that Peron loved." She told of their affair in a series of interviews after his overthrow.

In January 1956, the girl and her parents tried to join Peron in Paraguay, but Argentine federal police stopped them a few miles from the border. Nelly was placed in a rehabilitation school for minors and was released a year later.

In June 1958, she married Carlos Ramil, an Argentine clerk at the U. S. Embassy in Buenos Aires. A son was born 11 months later.

Peron has been living in Spain since 1960. He still has a large following in Argentina, particularly among the laboring class.

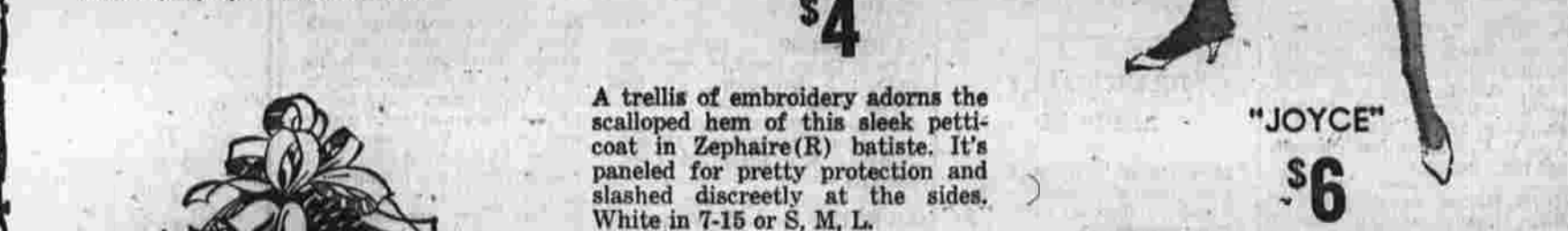

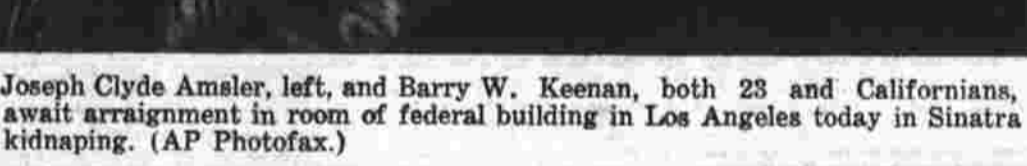

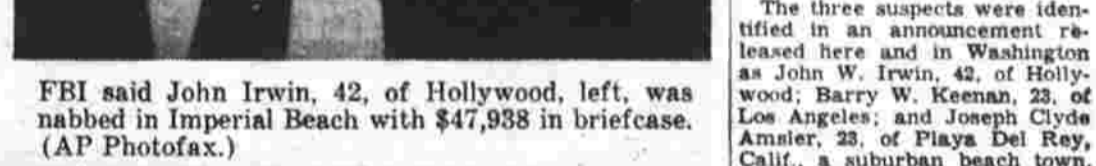
