MOSCOW (AP)—France expresses willingness today to supply complete chemical factories and other heavy industrial equipment to the Soviet Union in exchange for Russian machinery and equipment.

A joint Soviet-French committee favoring expanded trade between the two countries was formed today at the end of a week-long visit by French Foreign Minister Yveline Giscard d'Estaing.

After a meeting with Premier Khrushchev Tuesday, Giscard D'Estaing reported agreement in principle on an expanded five-year trade pact through 1968.

No figures were given. The Soviet Union has been shopping in the West for chemical equipment since Khrushchev launched a seven-year \$4-billion program to expand the chemical industry. The program includes more than \$1 billion for purchases from abroad.
