





Punishment Vs. Penance

The actual punishment of those Germans who are classified as war criminals, but whose crimes were, of course, much worse than those of war,-the actual punishment of these individuals is a relatively unimportant and almost superfluous thing, in itself.

That can be judged from examination of the post-Hitler career of Dr. Werner Hyde, who committed suicide in a West German cell yesterday. What is vital, what is all important, is the possibility that the German people,

and people everywhere who have had or who may still have instincts in the same diseased directions, should somehow be cleansed and made strong in decency and humanity.

The fact that the West German government, of its own accord and conscience, was determined once again to go through the ordeal of revealing and trying to exorcise the unbelievable and nspeakable barbarisms of the Hitler era does not illustrate a policy against the individual criminals, three of whom have already committed suicide rather than face trial.

It represents a policy of public realimation and penance.

That could very well be why three of defiance of hope and decency, to prevent the staging of the public spectacle of penance which the trials would pro-

How humanity is going to clean its soul of the unspeakable mass barbarism it committed, or tolerated, or failed to denounce in the Hitler era-that we still do not know.

But we focus, for a moment, on the individual life which came to an end yes-

Dr. Werner Hyde, who was, in this year 1964, charged with complicity in the murder of more than 100,000 mentally retarded people during the Hitler era, was interned by the United States Army back in 1945. He escaped from an army truck, took the name of Fritz Sawade, and spent the next 14 years in apparent safety writing medical opinions for a state insurance agency and a state social court. But, during this period, at least 18 of the officials with whom he was dealing came to know his real identity. They knew it in spite of the fact that, trying to make his hiding more secure, he had his own wife arrange to have him declared dead, after which she received a widow's pension, for which fraud she has now received a one-year

prison term. Perhaps some of these Germans who knew his identity, and who did not denounce it, were themselves uncured parts of the Hitler barbarism. Or perhaps they could see working through Hyde in the years of his superficial escape a punishfahment such as to make hanging by a belt seem a release and a blessing.

Regional Colleges

California, a pioneer in the develop-ment of two-year junior colleges, has de-veloped a new approach to financing construction of additional campuses. With more than 70 community co leges already in existence, several citie ave discovered that their tax base too limited to permit expansion. To solve the problem, a strong trend is under way regional as opposed to the present citywide basis.

By expanding the geographic area, the tax base is increased and new campuses can be financed with more ease. Th legislature, which seems to encourage this trend, expects that eventually every section of the state will be within a

They will be asked to approve formation of a junior-college district encompassing a region extending from the delta lowlands east of San Francisco Bay to Lake Tahoe and the peaks of the Sierra Nevada. Also on the ballot will be an \$18,000,-000 bond issue to expand the two junior
