WASHINGTON (AP)—In the news from Washington: BANK HOLDINGS: Noting that banks are being held up almost as often as in the heydays of the Dillinger gang, a House subcommittee has charged that neither banks nor federal agencies are doing enough about it. The subcommittee, headed by Rep. Dan Rostenkowski, urged federal banking agencies to consider regulations that would require banks to take more steps to guard against robberies and embezzlements. In its report Monday, the subcommittee said 48 banks were held up in 1963, an increase of 27 per cent over the year before, and in the first six months of 1964 bank holdups totaled 801. That would approach the record of 899 set in 1952 before Congress made bank robbing a federal crime. To thwart robbers, the subcommittee issued recommendations including bars and gates on all windows, tear gas guns activated by hand or foot controls and movie cameras to record holdups.

MOSCOW (AP)—Pravda, the Communist party paper, today reported a mine explosion in the Soviet Union that caused loss of life, something the Soviet government almost never admits.
