South Windsor Report Reflects Greater Fire Protection Demands

Steadily increasing demands for fire protection for townwide fire protection were spelled out in the annual report of the South Windsor Volunteer Fire Department covering the fiscal year 1963-64.

During the year, the report said, there was an increase of 24 alarms and 66 miscellaneous calls, while the number of man hours logged by the department increased by 1,832 over the total for 1962-63.

The total number of man hours put in by the department over the year amounted to 4,386. Fire calls answered by the department included: House fires, 16; commercial building fires, 7; barn fires, 4; grass fires, 1; dump fires, 5; motor vehicle fires, 22; school fires, 1; still alarms, 11; false alarms, 6; and mutual aid, 1.

Miscellaneous activities of the department included: Fire work details, 23; station drills, 2; and mutual aid drills, 2.

The department also installed a new 500-gallon-per-minute pumper and a new stall engine house. To the original pumper has been added a 200-p.m. pumper in 1963; a 700-p.m. pumper in 1962; and a new emergency truck in 1963.

Department apparatus is presently housed in two fire stations, one at Ellington Rd. and Foster Rd., and the other at Ellington Rd. and Beesbush Rd.

The department's radio communication system, inaugurated in the early 1960s, has a base station with three remote keying points, five two-way mobile units, one two-way portable unit and 33 tone-operated receivers in the hands of various firemen to alert them to an alarm.

Officers of the department want to build a new fire station in the northwest section of the town. The department has recommended that the new station be located at the corner of Sullivan Ave. rather than on Rt. 5 because of heavy traffic there. Minimum requirements for the proposed station are: full and complete building commission. The commission is requesting an appropriation of \$15,000 from the Town Council for preliminary plans.

One Minute Commercials Expensive

Ever wonder how much an advertiser has to pay for a one minute commercial during a time out period for a National Football League team? The going rate for a commercial minute on a CBS NFL telecast last season was \$45,000. Next season the one minute tab will be between \$60,000 and \$70,000.

CBS plans exclusive coverage of 95 NFL games this season. Did the network have any trouble lining up sponsors at the new one-minute tab? Not on your life.

There will be 10 time outs, at least, for each NFL game, with the sponsor taking six spots and the other four one-minute spots. Sponsors of a year ago were only too happy to receive their agreements, even at a substantial increase. Pro football is considered a prestige buy.

Not on your life. It is estimated that 15 million persons watched NFL telecasts last season. And another 6.2 million watched the AFL attractions.

Profits Due
It's interesting to note that the annual overhead of a pro team (either NFL or AFL) amounts to between \$800,000 and \$1 million, most of it in salaries. Under the new video package for each league, the TV money will pay the overhead, leaving stadium gate receipts for net profit.

With CBS offering a double-hour of football on a consecutive Sunday afternoon schedule in October, pro grid games will be held on every Sunday of continuous viewing.

If NFL, tv will fail to hold the interest, one can turn the dial and bring in the AFL games over the ABC network.

Tip to the lady of the house or the non-pro football fan: Some on the sport for a few arguments, too, on a Sunday afternoon next season.
