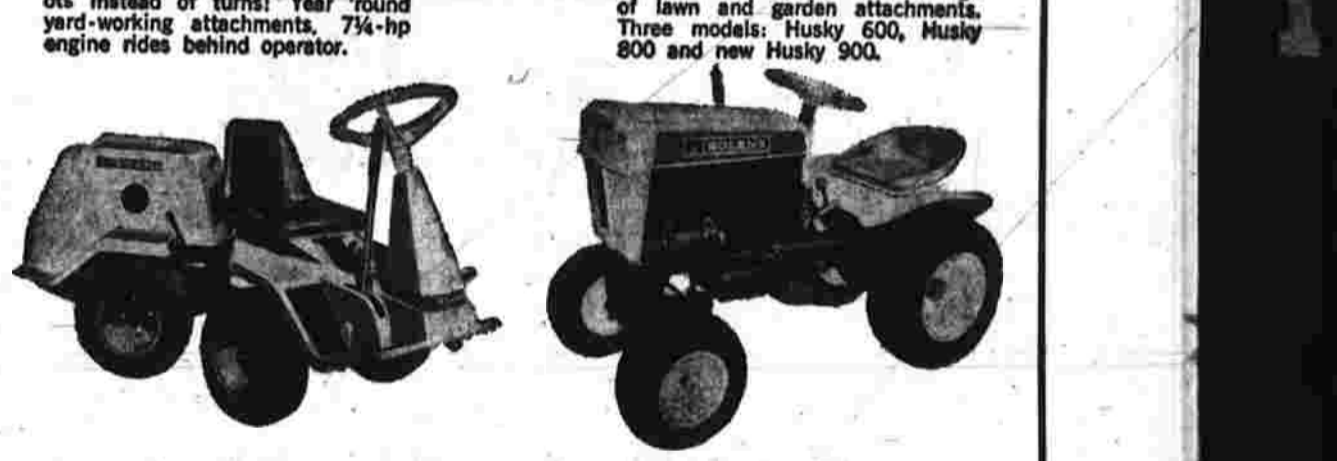

South Windsor Board of Education Eyes Addition for High School

A new addition to the South Windsor High School is being planned. The superintendent of schools, Merle R. Woodman, will inform the town council, town manager and the public building commission that the addition should be ready by September 1965. The new addition will increase the capacity of the high school from 800 to 1,200.

The board of education voted to assign Wapping School, Grades 7 and 8 to the high school for next year. The board said that to the maximum extent possible, these grades should continue to be integrated with Wapping School. The plan in these grades including art, music and physical education, will not be curtailed due to the transfer.

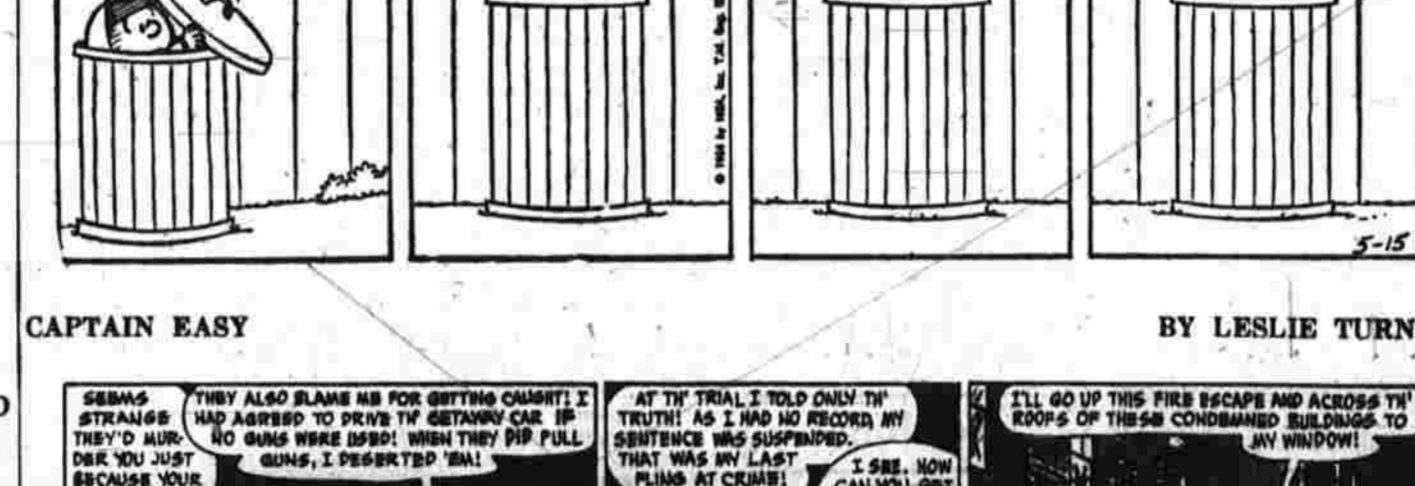
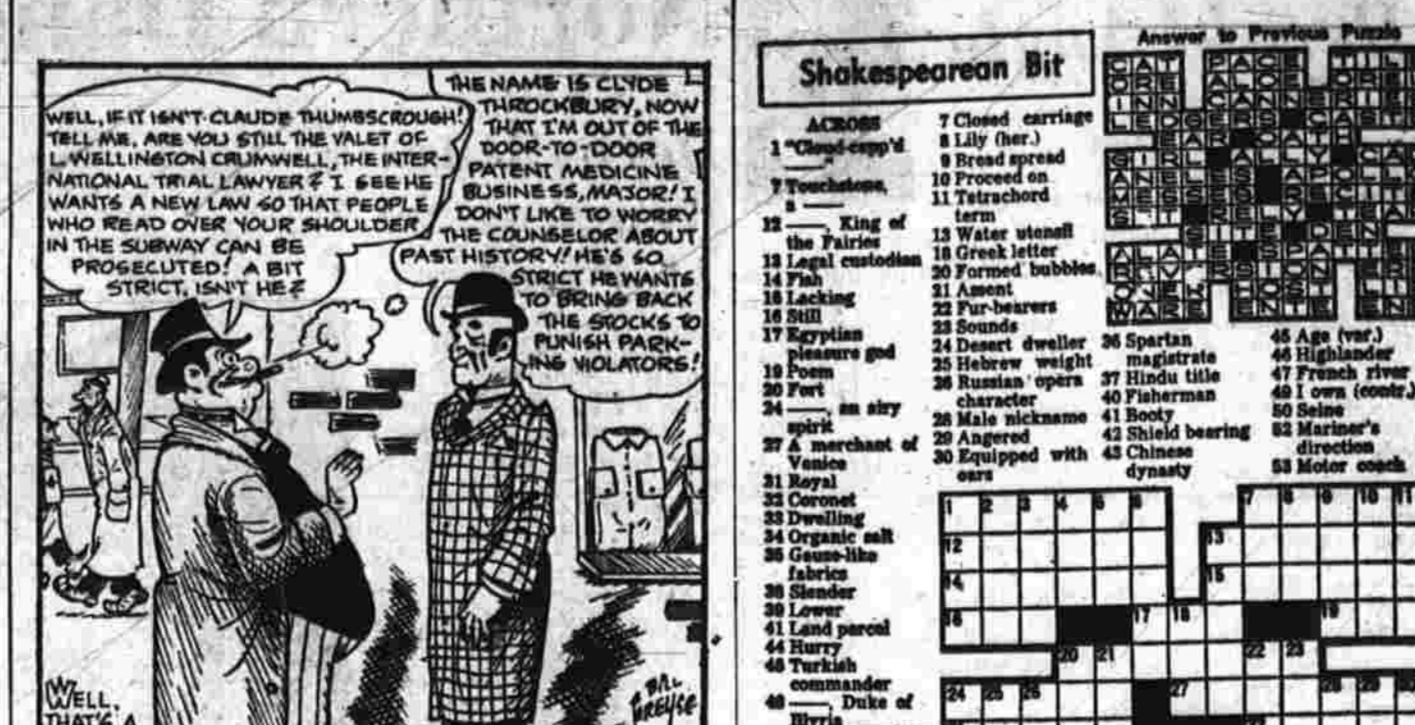
