Town Seeks Added Data On Nike Site

General Manager Richard Martin has written the General Services Administration (GSA) requesting information on possible town purchase of the Keeney St. Nike site.

Martin's letter refers to a previous GSA letter which questioned the length of time being taken by the town to consider the purchase.

The General Manager asked for clarification of rights-of-way and other easement matters. He also informed the federal officials that besides considering the property for recreation and water utilization purposes the town is also considering the site for educational purposes.

He mentioned that plans of these proposals would follow later.

The 3-acre site has been made available to the town on a "first refusal" purchase basis by federal agency administering the disposal of the surplus property.

Town officials have been quoted as saying that very favorable purchase prices are available to the town if it chooses to exercise its priority of purchase for special uses such as schools or parks.

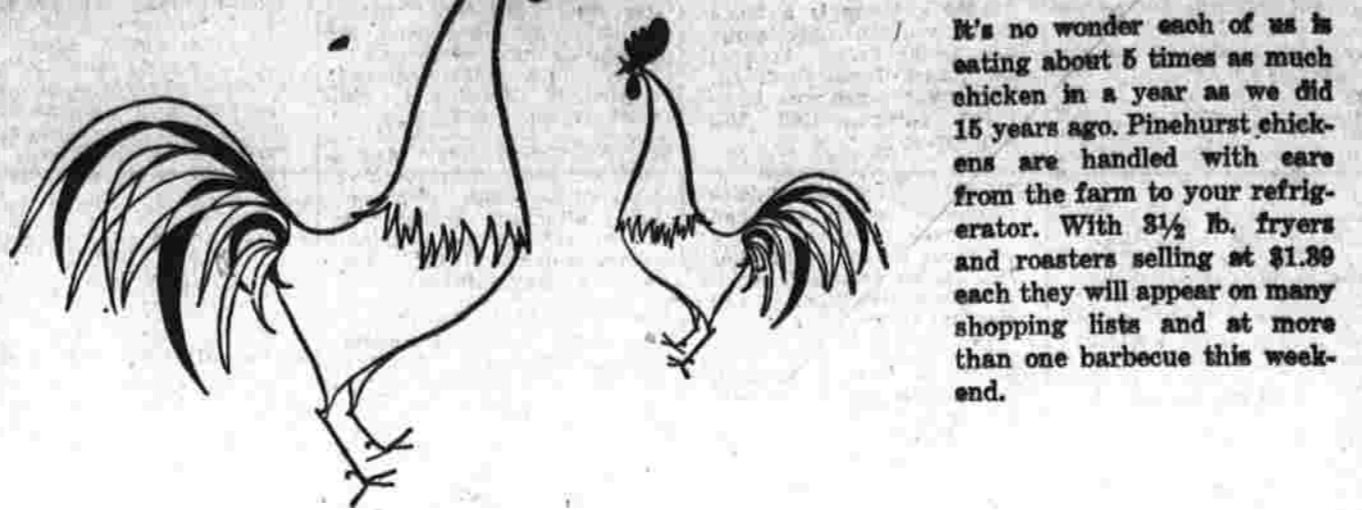
Fava Bid Low On Razing Job

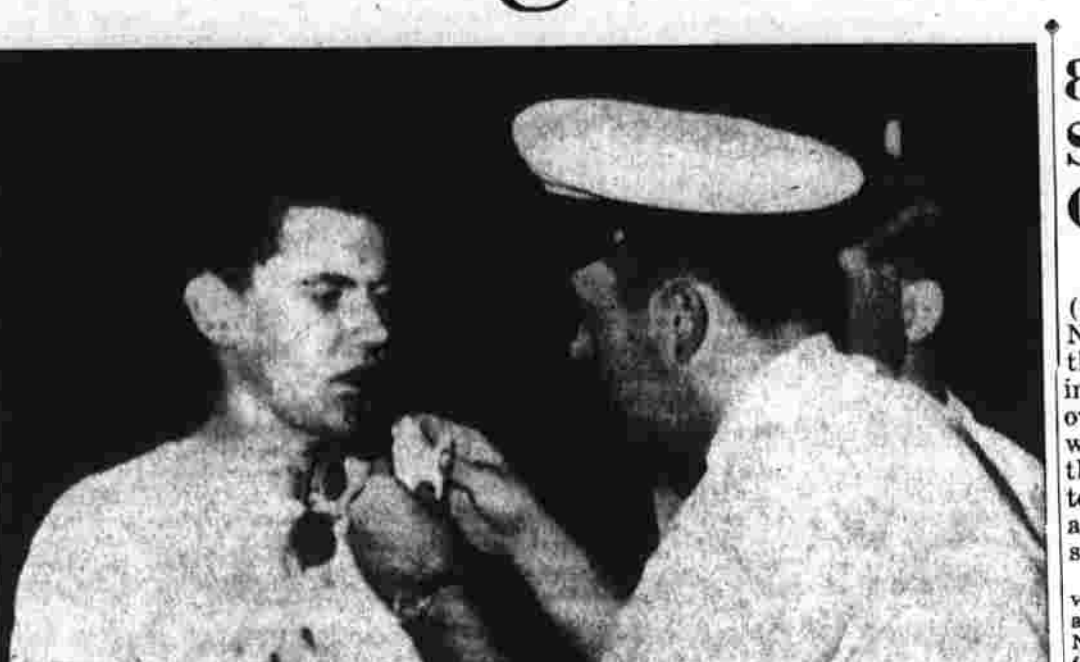
