Membership with its hemisphere neighbors... For President-elect Frei represented the much more favorable choice between two candidates...

But his prime opponent, Senator Salvador Allende Gossens, had not only sounded as if he planned to change things by enacting them around a bit first, but he had so much backing from Communist propaganda sources that his victory, if it had materialized, would have been classified as a victory for Communism, Catholicism, and Marxism...

What has happened, instead, is the victory of a man who, in his character and in his associations, is being characterized as a "reformer of the democratic left," something like President Betan-court in Venezuela and the newly elected President Terry of Pure Fausibus in Chile...

But a Communist victory in Chile would have been a major development, comparable, in this hemisphere, to such a thing as the Communist victory in Cuba...

Political Allies... The reversal of this year's natural political alignments is illustrated in a reverse way in the Arkansas gubernatorial race where the decision over whether Barry Goldwater is an asset or liability seems to be a key in campaign strategy...

There Republican candidate Winthrop Rockefeller has embraced Goldwater, thus reducing the possibility that Democratic Governor Orval Faubus might do as he has through...

Back To The Charges... When we may charge, at the State Capitol yesterday, both before and after the somewhat notorious adjournment of the special session of the General Assembly, in which one political party sought all the blame to the other...

But perhaps a major share of the blame for the inability of the two parties to do constructive and honorable business together in this special session lies in the nature of Connecticut history, the nature of the task, and the extraordinary personality character of the candidates headed them by the panel of Federal Judges...

As a result the special session itself occurred in complete futility and, because such futility affected the temper of our good mood on both sides, the special session adjourned in a somewhat shameful, the Connecticut system, beyond contributing itself to the very founding of this present nation, had supported with trepidation and honor and dignity for some 200 years; it was tragedy, and perhaps needless tragedy, that it should have been turned into a makeshift scene which was so unbecomingly the worst performance in all its long history...

There may be some lesson in this, if there is some study of it all in the past few years of Federal judges who now hold the fate of Connecticut public life in their hands. Let these judges realize, one hopes, the depth of the roots to the past they are seeking to cut; let them realize some of the endless refinements and important subsidiary considerations which must be involved in any attempt to install and operate a new order, even when it is done from the bench; let the judge try to avoid any greater travesty on the ideas of political justice and fair representation than have ever been involved in the imperfections of the past...

What a monstrous thing it would be, for instance, if the federal judges should now order a state at large election of all members of both House and Senate, and that decree that the next General Assembly would most probably have in its midst 294 representatives and 26 senators out of one party, all Democrats if that party should happen to carry the state, and all Republicans if that party should carry the state...

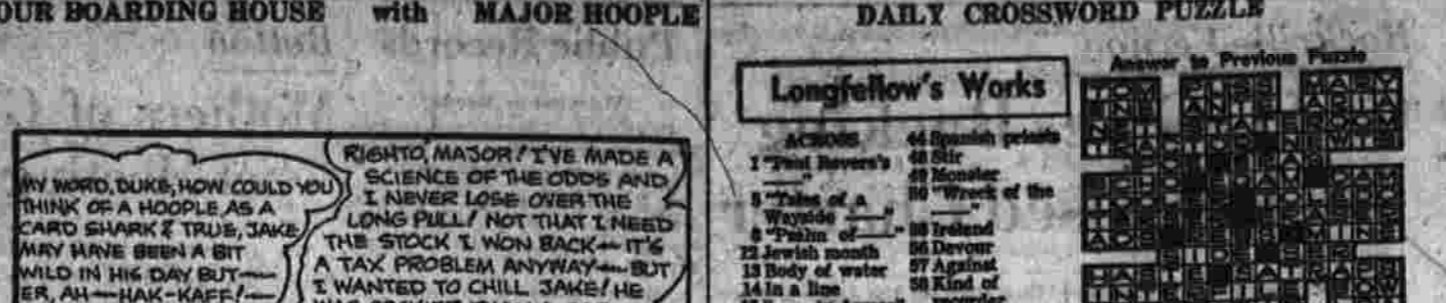
