Official Hits Those 'Using' School Budget Shows 15% Rise

MERRIDEN (AP)—The secretary of the Democratic State Central Committee has lashed out at people who say "attempts to use the school budget as a political tool."

Henry Alibello, long-term party secretary and former mayor of Meriden, said such people are threatening to primary against Ribicoff "in an effort to obtain delegates to the national convention for the presidential candidate."

Alibello's statement released Wednesday mentioned no names but was regarded as a slam at supporters of Sen. Eugene J. McCarthy, D-Minn., for president.

Tollard School Budget Shows 15% Rise

The proposed Board of Education budget for next year stands at \$1,426,272, representing a 15 per cent increase over last year. The budget is subject to adjustment when the teachers' salaries are agreed upon.

The 15 per cent increase is necessitated primarily by a 21 per cent increase in enrollment for additional teachers, textbooks, transportation and equipment to be used by these students. These must be provided for kindergarten and high school students.

Last year's budget was \$1,239,617 compared to this year's \$1,276,985 for the same expense.

New personnel adds another \$165,338 to the budget, and \$1,800 in differentials are added, raising the budget to the \$1,426,272 total.

This year's 1,608-student enrollment is expected to jump to 2,100 in September according to last year's school enrollment reports of children actually living in town as of last October.

All accounts with the exception of tuition students show increases in the new budget. The Outgoing Transfers Account decreases from \$202,800 last year to \$123,000 this year.
