Uncluttered Simplicity Makes House Spacious

The day was a negative, November one when we visited the home of Mr. and Mrs. John McCandless at 42 Echo Drive in Vernon. But once inside the door, ample uncluttered off-white wall space, a splash of hot yellow and orange in upholstery and a window wall which overlooks a peaceful valley made the day seem bright.

An open stairway is the only break in an otherwise open area combining the living room and dining room. A floor covering of pale avocado coordinates the rooms and stairway.

The yellow-orange-gold-black floral pattern covering the sectional love-seats in a corner of the living room are like a splash of autumn leaves. Boldly, yet with careful discipline, Mrs. McCandless has painted a free form design which hangs over the mantel in the hot yellow and orange colors of the love seat covering.

A chair upholstered in bright yellow was done by Mrs. McCandless in an adult education class. She said she had such a feeling of accomplishment when she had completed this particular assignment. A green leather occasional armchair faces the yellow one in front of the large wall window.

Wall space is unbroken except for three black and white sketches in narrow antiqued green frames depicting winter, spring and fall. Delicately painted on three lamp bases are sprays of herbs, wild flowers and even peas.

The mantel was taken down to a rough, bare wood finish in stark contrast to the white fireplace and chimney. Delicately decorating the mantel are two low antique brass candlesticks with pale green candles and a small arrangement of wild grasses with a bright red little bird perched on a tuber root mounted on a flat stone.

The fireplace is flanked by a copper and wrought iron torse. A turquoise painted wooden bucket containing bright terracotta, an archaeological find of the McCandlesses, adorns the coffee table.

The small dining room seems not so small because of well-proportioned furnishings. A small Hepplewhite sideboard, covered with old black gunk when we bought it, said Mrs. McCandless, has been restored to a beautiful glow. Small cane-seated chairs, antiqued in green, and a refinished drop leaf table complete the furnishings except for a small book table, also antiqued in green, on which rests a small silver bowl of gourds. In this room, also, is a wide window area granting a magnificent view.

What had been an open pass-through between the kitchen and dining room has been filled in with dark stained wooden louvered doors which may be opened or closed. Curtains in the kitchen are a bold gold and brown print. "That was material I had intended for a dress," explained Mrs. McCandless, "so there went my dress."

Tito Says Yugoslavia Can Defend Itself Alone

JACER, Yugoslavia (AP) — President Tito said today Yugoslavia is strong enough to defend its sovereignty and independence alone. He said he had no reason why the Soviet Union should attack Yugoslavia, a reference to Soviet-Yugoslav tension since the invasion of Czechoslovakia. Tito told a news conference of 200 foreign and Yugoslav newsmen "It would be desirable not to dramatize the present situation. Relaxation should be endeavored."

He also said Yugoslavia does not ask for any protection from the North Atlantic Treaty Organization, adding, "I think everywhere in the world everybody knows that we did not ask anybody to help us."

Questioned about a statement by U.S. Secretary of State Dean Rusk in Brussels that Yugoslavia is part of the "Grey Zone" of NATO protection, Tito said, "Our attitude stands apart from his appraisal. We do not recognize spheres of interest. These stop at our borders. Here is a bright zone and we have no reason to be afraid."

Asked whether reports about possible Warsaw Pact maneuvers in Romania are worrying Yugoslavia, Tito replied: "As far as I know in the near future, these maneuvers are not foreseen. Why should we worry if Romania, which is a member of

Events in World People in The News

Chung-Dee Park said today South Korea has become too strong economically and militarily for the North Korean army to renew its invasion of the South. "North Korea alone is incapable in military and economic terms to subjugate the South to Communist rule by overt aggression. If it dares to attempt, it will only lead to self-run on the part of the Communist North," Park said. Foreign Minister Chul Kyu-bah said he would appear before the U.N. Political Committee Dec. 12 to report on increased North Korean aggression, including invasion by commando teams which attempted to assassinate President Park last January and by guerrilla cadres on South Korea's coast in early November.

Japan's Sato Picks Cabinet

TOYO (AP) — Prime Minister Eisaku Sato today named a new cabinet which political observers said reflects his pledge to "get things done." Sato, re-elected Wednesday as chief of Japan's conservative Liberal Democratic party and thus as prime minister, will have only one holdover in his "action Cabinet." 'Death Squad' Spreads Panic Through Rio

RIO DE JANEIRO (AP) — Brazil's Death Squad, a clandestine organization described by the press as a vigilante committee of off-duty policemen, is expanding its operations.

About 200 deaths of criminals accused must have been attributed to the squad in the last 10 years, although there is often no clear way to distinguish its executions from gangland murders.

The organization claimed its latest victim this week in a new territory, Sao Paulo. The body of a young man, believed by police to have been a small-time gangster, was found from directions telephoned by a man calling himself the squad's public relations officer.

Some of the killings here are the signature—bloody letters, often from machine guns, call to a small left-hand side of the bodies, and a telephone call to police or a newspaper giving the location of the killing.

The squad made its first execution in Sao Paulo Nov. 21. They also made public a list of 17 future victims. Four days later one of those mentioned in the list was dead.

In Rio, the squad also registered another first last week with the killing of its first victim, a small-time gangster, in the slums of the city.
