**MAKE YOUR GAME BY STEALING TIME**  
By ALFRED SHEINWOLD

The most satisfying way to use an ace is to capture an opponent's king with it. You're almost equally happy if you get an opponent's queen or jack. But if you get nothing but small cards for your ace, you have been picked. In today's hand East refused to let his pocket be picked, but declarer stole time to make his contract anyway.

Opening lead—six of hearts.  
West opened the six of hearts, East put up the king, and South won with the ace. Terence Reese, playing the South hand in an English tournament, saw that he might lose a diamond trick if he tried to develop that suit. Then the opponents would knock out the queen of hearts, and he would have only two spades, two hearts and four diamonds.

South thought of leading a low club at the second trick but felt sure that East had the ace of clubs for his layout double. East would capture the king of clubs with the ace and would return a heart. Now the contract would depend on winning three club tricks, and the odds were almost 2 to 1 against such a good luck as a 3-3 break of the six missing clubs.

**Leads Through East**  
Reese solved his problem by getting to dummy with a spade and leading dummy's low club. This put poor East on the horns of a dilemma.

If East put up the ace of clubs, South would play low. Then he could surely win the three club tricks he needed for his contract.

Unwilling to accept nothing for his ace, East played a low club. Reese therefore won the trick with the jack of clubs. Now he had time to go after the diamonds. West got the

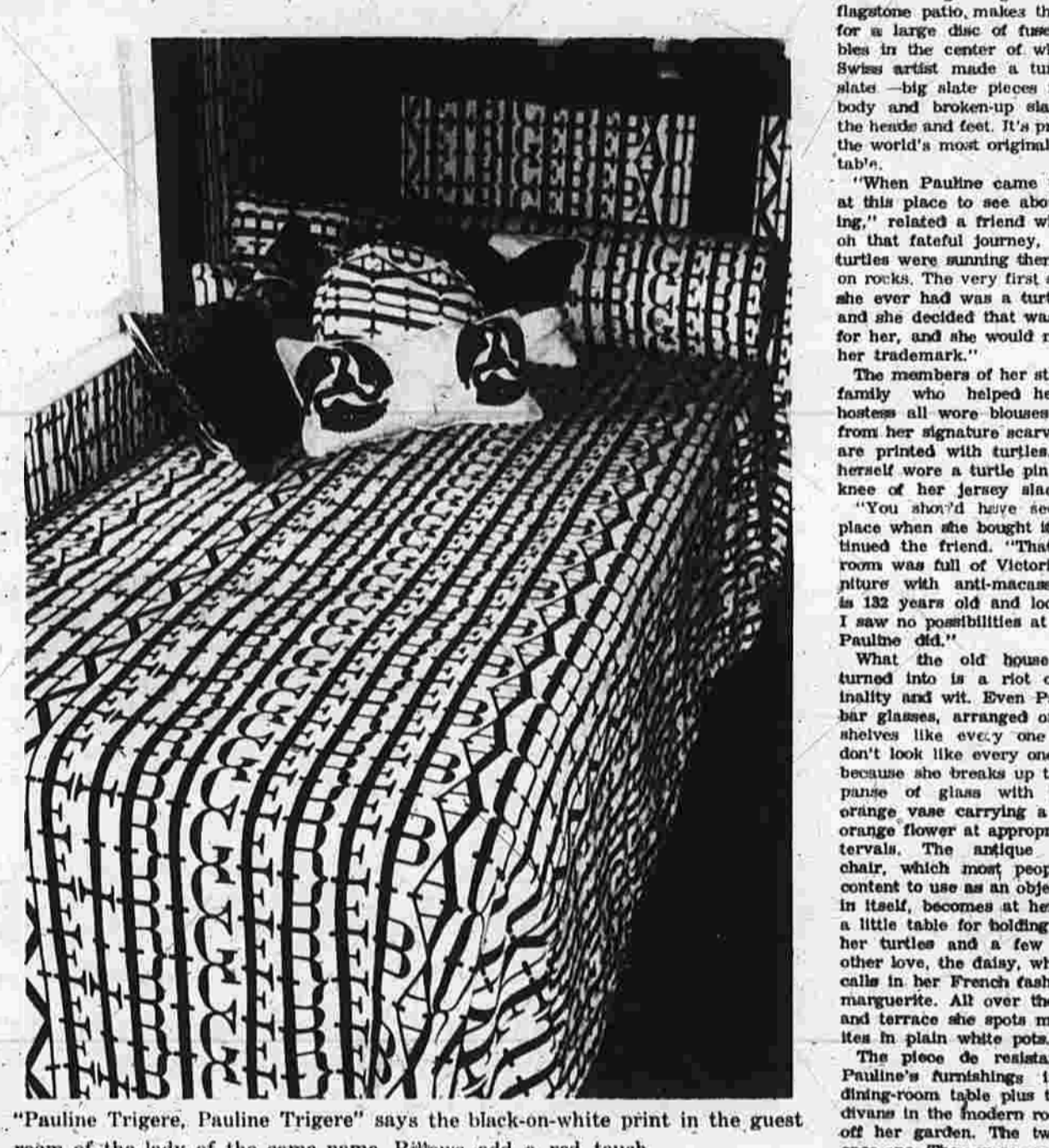

# Lunch with Trigere at La Tortue

For a long time, the people of Lewisboro, N. Y., which is just over the Connecticut border from New Canaan, thought their neighbor with the French accent was named Mrs. La Tortue. The neighbors must have been dumb-founded when they saw the turtle, theme of the most industrial fashion designer in her adopted country, and "La Tortue" the name of her home. It means "The Turtle."

To the fashion editors of the United States, press of the American Designers Service meant not only a view of the new fall clothes but an invitation to lunch with Trigere at La Tortue. The neighbors must have been dumb-founded when three large buses pulled up outside what seems, from the road, just a modest, old-fashioned white house. Inside, nothing is modest and certainly not old-fashioned. Back, back stretches a great area of grass and trees, a natural pond makes the swimming pool with constantly refreshed water (reminding one of the old pig who had money), and lots of white furniture with cushions of pristine white textured vinyl.

And everywhere tables. The current count is 528. Stone tables perching on the oversized rock garden that surrounds the property, spruce dried turtles on either side a doorway, small turtles in all materials, including across table tops. The trunk of a tree growing from the flagstone patio, makes the base for a large disc of fused pebbles in the center of which a Swiss artist made a turtle. The table—big slate pieces for the body and broken-up slate for the turtle and feet. It's a work of the world's most original coffee table.

"When Pauline came to look at this place to see about buying," related a friend who was with her that fateful journey, "the turtles were sunning themselves on rocks. The very first success she ever had was a turtle pin, and she decided that was lucky for her, and she would make it her trademark."

The members of her staff and family who helped her stay in business all were blown away from her signature scarves that are printed with turtles. She has herself worn a turtle pin, and her jewelry is also turtles.

"I've heard her say this place when she bought it," continued the friend. "That living thing that she bought it with, a turtle with anti-macramé. It is 12 years old and looked it. I saw it in a magazine at all but Pauline did it."

What the old house is a riot of color and pattern. The bar glasses, arranged on glass shelves like every one else's because she breaks up that essence of glass with a tiny orange flower at appropriate intervals. The antique chairs, which most people are content to use as an object of art in their homes, are here in a little table for holding one of her turtles and a few of her other love, the daily, which she calls in her French fashion the "table." All over the house are turtles and turtles in all sizes in plain white pots.

Not To Fear Our Own Shadows

It is a safe guess that most of us who voice or write this appropriate sentiment on the occasion of this nation's birthday would never had been alive back then—have led or even supported the Revolution which gave the original birth.

When we write or speak of America we do so as representatives and members of an establishment; the Revolution was a combination of inflammatory intellectuals with irresponsible rabble against the establishment.

We, who draw deep, proud breaths as we think of our country today, are likely to be law and order people.

Those who created this country for us were wild ones, acting irrationally and in defiance of existing codes and values.

Now and then some of us law and order establishment men and women get the idea that perhaps no much pressure for change is building up underneath, inside our happy national structure.

In such moments, we reach into our bag of ideological reasons and come out with the noble sentiment that this is a continuing revolution, not any closed, finished story.

But if we were to confess the truth to ourselves, it would probably have to be that we have no more real ineffectual toward change than King George had in his day, and that we might think we were guiding ourselves toward the quietest and easiest and neatest way if we could hire a few redcoats to sweep radical theories about injustice under the rug.

Perhaps no one could have changed or persuaded King George and his ministers, not even by the most eloquent and persuasive prediction of what might come if he did not learn how to recognize the real need for changes in the existing social and political and economic structure of their world.

We, with all our orate pretenses at liberal understanding, with all our continual admonitions to be more fully aware of the fact that we live in a changing world, with all the many steps we are given of pressures and pressures powerful enough to keep erasing the area and in every institution—we should have a slightly better chance than King George and his ministers of getting our eyes and minds at least partially open to the "options" of our time.

Once again, as it was before, it may be that the "outset" intellectuals, the irresponsible rabble, have some kind of freak link to what tomorrow is going to have to be, and that they carry the torch for the real America with a much legitimacy as we, the more stolid ones, bring to our celebration of the Revolution, which have us both. We must not be afraid of our own shadows.

Taking Joy Out Of Borrowing

Under the federal Truth In Lending Law, which came into being on July 1, those of us who like to listen to the stress of the time plans will no longer have any valid excuse for pleading that we do not really know just what they really cost.

Under the new law, any lender must now provide a borrower with two pieces of information.

First, the lender must provide a figure which will be the total finance charge the borrower will have to pay, and this figure is to include everything—direct and indirect, from interest, fees, "points," service charges, and insurance.

Second, the lender has to match this total finance charge against the amount of credit and come up with an annual interest rate, based on the amount of credit, or who, in the past, may have been told that his interest rate was to be one and one half per cent, monthly will now have it put down that he will be paying 18 per cent interest annually.

The new law is welcome. At the same time, consider complete the admission that the man whose borrowings in the past have not been getting the total finance charge or the true rate of interest they are going to pay is that they themselves do not want to know such statistics, and would rather not know the true extent of their own desperation or foolishness.

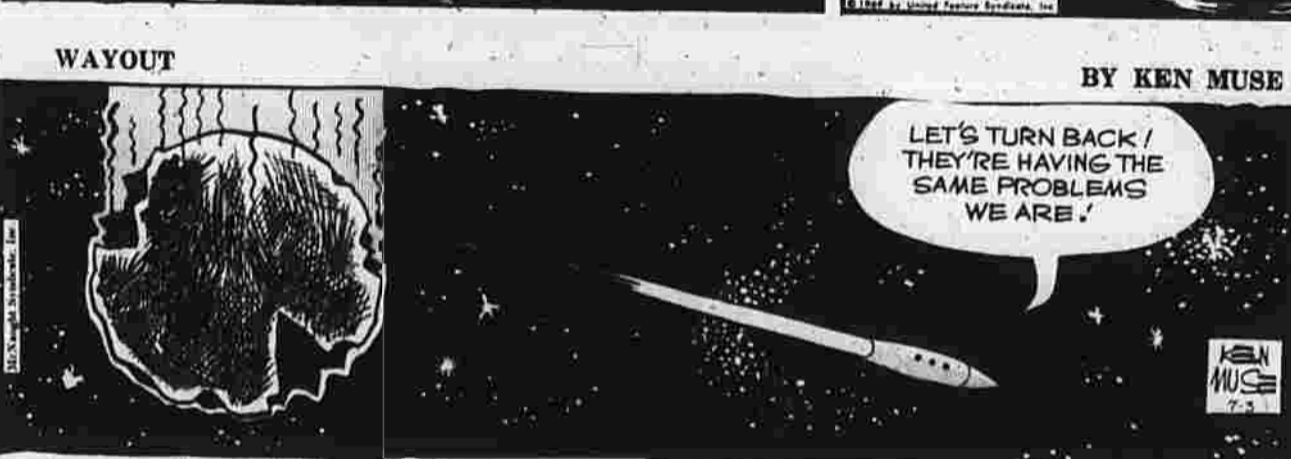

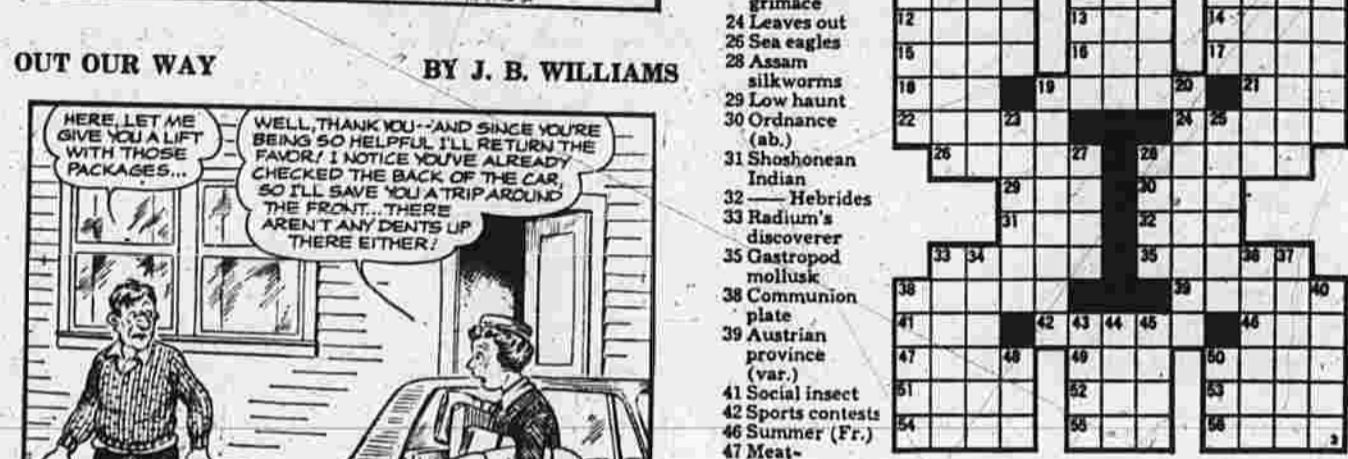

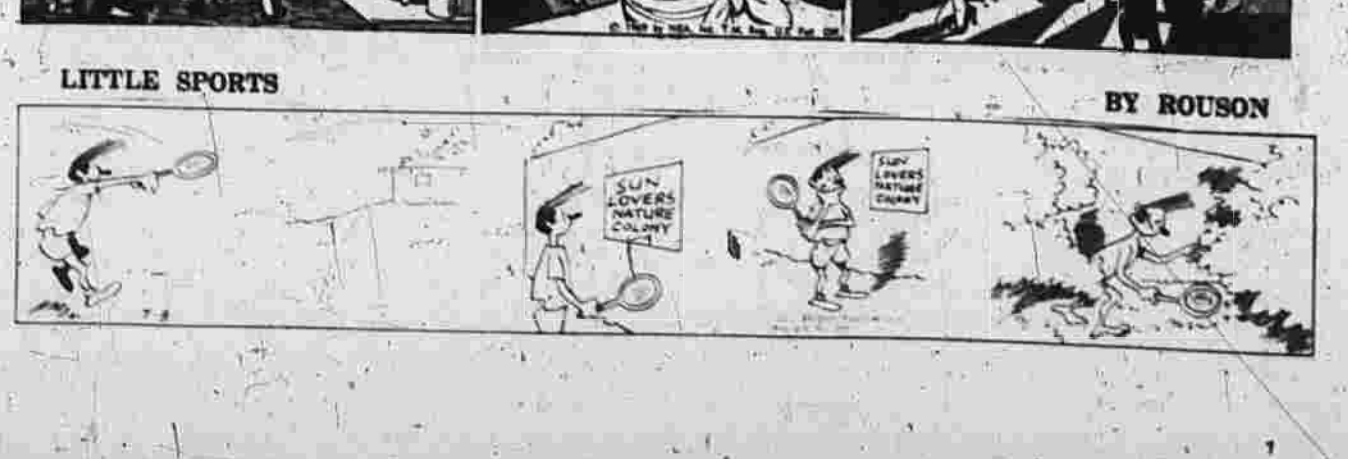
