

'Bucky' Retires As MMH Housekeeper

Mrs. Marion Buckler, who for nearly 25 years has had charge of keeping Manchester Memorial Hospital shining clean, retires tomorrow from her post of executive housekeeper.

She'll be leaving a big job that would give a hospital housewife nightmares — the planning and supervising of all inside housekeeping at MMH. This includes the cleaning of acres of rooms and corridors, plus doing the laundry for more than 800 patients.

"Each of these days, I had charge of receiving and distributing supplies, too," she recalled. "But that's all changed now. As we grew, receiving and supply was made a separate function.

"Planned for and providing the housekeeping for that portion of the hospital will fall on the shoulders of Ralph Giannotti, 41 of England, who joined the MMH staff earlier this month and will succeed Mrs. Buckler.

War Has Claimed 4,008 U.S. 'Copters

SAIGON (AP) — The U.S. 4,008 helicopters have been lost to all causes in North and South Vietnam, Laos and Cambodia since Jan. 1, 1964, a spokesman said. The U.S. Command's weekly summary of aircraft losses said more than a billion dollars worth of helicopters were shot down in South Vietnam, 28 in Cambodia, 10 in North Vietnam and nine in Laos. Another 2,520 were destroyed as the result of rock, mortar and other attacks on the ground, mechanical failures, air collisions and pilot error.

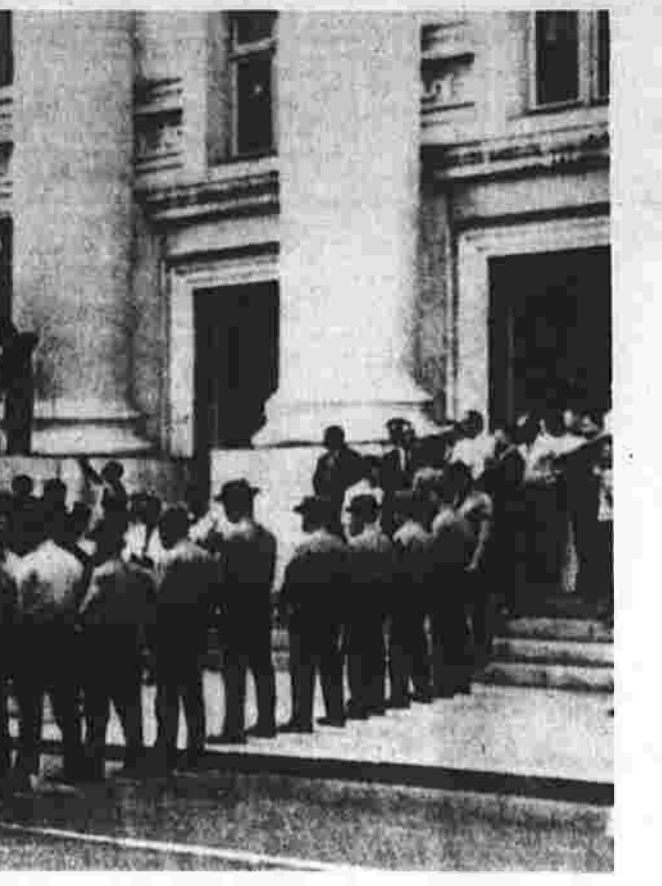


(AP Photo) An Egyptian soldier is ready for trouble as he controls his side of the Suez Canal on Thursday.

Cholera Coverup Charged

GENEVA (AP) — The World Health Organization charged today that certain governments are deliberately covering up cases of cholera and stated that the disease "is spreading more rapidly than indicated by official notifications."

But he said that if cholera is officially confirmed in Guinea "it would be serious" because it would be the first time the disease had ever penetrated Africa south of the Sahara.
