The series is in celebration of the United States' bicentennial, and will be broadcast from time to time throughout the will feature a conversation be tween CBS News national correspondent Eric Sevareld and key figures in the blith of American independence - the first to be portrayed by Academy Award-winning actor Pote Uatinov.
In the first eptrode, "A Conversation With Lard North, to will portray King George III's Prime Minister Frederick Lord North, the pivotal figure in the decision to resint colonial efforts at independence.

Sevareld, in contemporary drems, questions Lond North as he might have done from the vantage potnt of an American journalist of the year 1770 .

Sevareld interviews Lord North about many of the fasues that agitated the colonists and pushed them to the verge of revolution - among them the Boston "massacre," the AmerIcan claim of lack of representation in Parilament, the tax mposed on tea and the crucial cal factor in the ultimate outbreak of hostilites.
Lond North is generally acknowledged as the man most responalible, after King George himself, for the uprising in the colonies. He has been portray tinov's portrayal as that of " a
