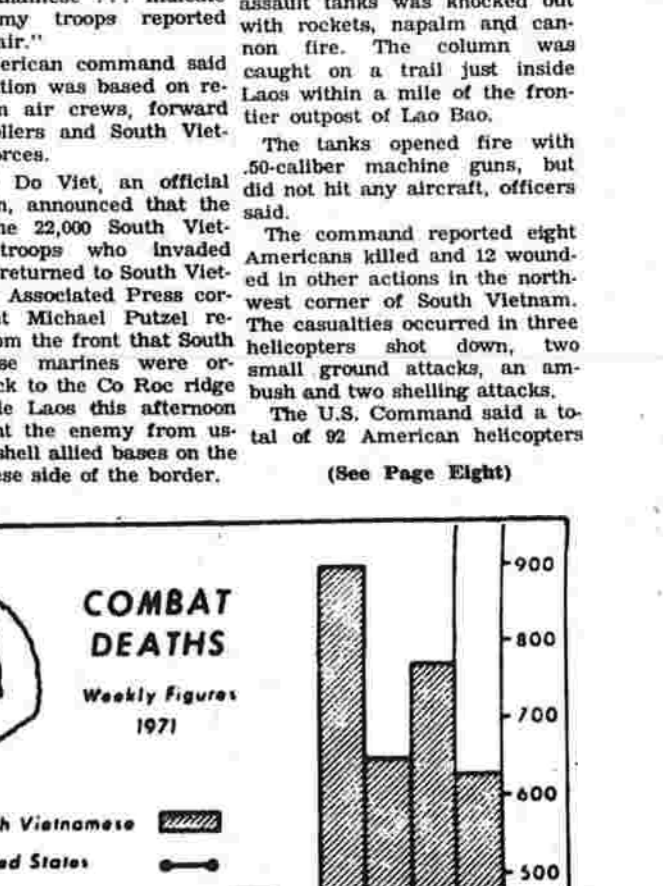

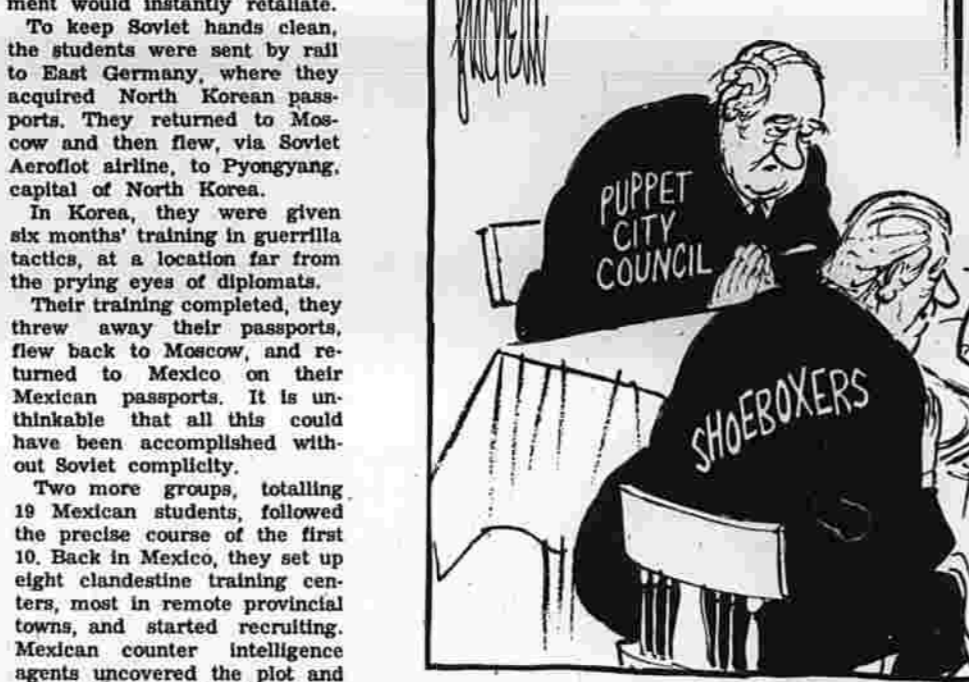

People Who Knew Hoffman Now Come to Know His Art

By JUNE LINTON (Herald Reporter)

Asking repeatedly, "Did you know Gustave Hoffman?" one comes to expect the resounding "yes" assuming that the person queried lived in Rockville in the years before 1945.

People are quick to describe him as a character always, sometimes the proud eccentric, dressed to the hilt, making entrances with his ever-present sister Martha a few steps away, gold-tipped cane, long hair and very much in character as the artist, lecturer and traveler.

Or they describe him in his last years, still the eccentric, bundled against the cold in a long black overcoat, always ten or a dozen inches under his hair sticking out from under his cap, gruff and frightening to children and heartbreakingly poor.

"This is the Gustave Hoffman of Rockville past, at least in the minds of its people who remember the man rather than his art. Now in retirement people may set aside their images and look at the work of the artist."

Hoffman is noted especially for his etchings, and a number of these, along with oils, water colors and pastels are on exhibit at the Rockville Public Library through April 1. The Memorial Exhibit has been collected on loan from present owners of his work by the Vernon Historical Society, and unless one knows what miracle of existence, remained out of a surprising show.

His finest work most people are quick to agree are his etchings. The sample acquired includes a few aquatint prints in red, blue and black. Most of them are simple sketches of places, herons, birds, and sometimes exploding in detail, sometimes weak in a sea of snow or obnoxious fields.

They are lovely compositions and a listing of works in various art galleries accepting his work includes the Royal Gallery at Munich, the Art Gallery at Frankfurt, the national galleries in Berlin and Leipzig, and the British Museum in London besides many collections in this country which include the Walden, Albenus and Library of Congress.

Not everything in the show is comparable to the etching and a few pieces done in Egypt bear little resemblance to his other work so much so one wonders that he actually did them.

Hoffman was born in Germany of French extraction in 1880 shortly before his father obtained work in one of Rockville's woolen mills as a designer and sent for his family which included eight children at the time. Hoffman dropped out of high school when it was necessary to work in the mills to help support the family. The talented young artist finally managed to receive an art education with the help of an older brother and quite possibly other unidentified persons.

He studied at the National Academy in New York City from 1909 to 1910 and then at the Academy of Fine Arts in Munich from 1910 to 1914. He traveled extensively in Europe accumulating much knowledge which would be valuable to him later on in his life when he turned to lecturing as a means of support.

He eventually returned to live out his years in Rockville with his sister, and the house at 5 Laurel St. where they lived still overlooks many of the scenes he imprinted into the surface of the copper plates for

him by the Etchings Women's Club and in delight Hoffman presented the organization with a set of etchings. These are included in the present showing which finally came about, 25 years after his death.

Some of these might well have been the landscapes in oil on exhibit in the borrowed collection. Some seem to be studies of sunlit hills with its sparkling pinks, blues and yellows while others reflect the somber mood of shadowy places done in etching of color which may be a birch tree or light glancing from a rock.

Stories are told about the poverty in which he lived out his final years, at times using his work in exchange for goods and services. One woman remembered her father acquiring ten or a dozen etchings when they were offered in payment for needed items like dry goods stores; and the story is repeated by others.

Bartered or bought, the paintings and etchings found their way into the homes of many local people and perhaps because of this they were the most easily acquired for the show. The search which took months became an experience in frustration for one of the society members leading it.

Mrs. J. Fenton Burke described the difficulties of locating scattered relatives and of dealing with institutions which are not inclined to think kindly of loaning works of art. Entire sets of etchings remained beyond reach and the copper plates themselves, some hopefully still in existence, remained out of a surprising show.

HARTFORD (AP) — The House signaled the end of Connecticut's unique driver hand signals Wednesday by passing and sending to the governor a bill that would standardize them.

Connecticut is the only state which has not adopted the hand signals in the Uniform Traffic Safety Code, said Rep. David Sullivan, R-Bridgeport.

The most unusual Connecticut signal is the hand-twirling signal for a right turn—a signal which has confused many an out-of-state motorist.

It's true that all autos have been equipped with electric turn signals, but hand signals are still needed when the turn lights malfunction. Sullivan explained in answer to a question from Rep. Rufus Rose, R-Waterford.

"The Connecticut Safety Commission is preparing to conduct an educational program to make sure drivers know about the new signals," Sullivan said.

Roving Bands Invade Cities In Brazil

RECIFE, Brazil (AP) — With drooping heads and weary expressions, roving bands of peasants are invading cities and towns in search of food and work.

The situation is so desperate that one group was seen fighting with the bus drivers and each other for the carcasses of an ox.

Government officials estimate that hundreds of thousands of peasants are going hungry and thirsty as the year-long drought persists over areas the size of France and Germany.

"They leave their land in the hopes of finding employment in the towns. But there is little work available, and many just move on to another town."

In the seventh such incident this week, groups of 50 peasant families on Wednesday walked into the city of Gramahuns, in the State of Pernambuco, and camped in the main square. They were given food and drink but no work.

Last year, the government started a program of making construction projects, employing jobless peasants at 50 cents a day. But the government says the program is too costly and has been phased it out.

States Give Lower Vote Swift Action

By THE ASSOCIATED PRESS

Many state legislatures are taking swift action to approve the proposed 26th Amendment to the U.S. Constitution that would extend the voting franchise for all elections to 18 year olds.

Seven states—Minnesota, Delaware, Tennessee, Connecticut, Massachusetts, Washington and Hawaii—had ratified the proposal by late Wednesday.

In Arkansas, Maine and Michigan, the amendment had been approved by the state House of Representatives, and sent to the Senate. In Texas the state Senate had given approval and House action was awaited.

A total of 38 state legislatures plan to take the amendment before it becomes part of the Constitution. The states began considering the measure after it was approved by Congress Tuesday.

Congress had approved last year a bill lowering the voting age to 18 for all elections. But the Supreme Court ruled in December that the law applied only to federal elections.

This raised the possibility of costly dual registration and voting procedures to cover both state and local elections, and the amendment was proposed to remedy the situation.

Other state legislatures that plan to take the amendment under consideration soon include Nebraska, Vermont, Florida, New York, Nevada, Rhode Island, Virginia, Oregon, Arizona and Indiana.

In three states, there were indications that there would be no action on the proposal.

A resolution for ratification has passed the Maryland House of Delegates but has been sent to the state constitution to lower the voting age in state and local elections was adopted Tuesday.

In Oklahoma, a resolution was introduced in the House but Republican Gov. John A. Love said the Colorado legislature tied this session. "It can be handled next year," he said, "with any potential rights of 18-year-olds," Love said.

From Your Neighbor's Kitchen

By VIVIAN F. FERGUSON

When I was a very little girl, I would flip through the magazines and look at the pictures. I loved trademarks. I knew the chick who hadn't scratched yet, the little boy with the cabbie tires, and the Dutch lady with the stick in her hand. I had a hang-up on the Dutch character. She was fearless since her cap covered her face, and besides she had that threatening stick. I had a few nightmares in each of which I managed to escape her wrath.

My favorite trademark was two cute little kids who occupied, in rhyme, the merits of soup. They were roly-poly, chubby-faced children with sparkling personalities. Called "The Campbell Kids," they were created by Grace Waldstein Drayton who looked into the mirror one day and drew a self-portrait. She was "just a kid" herself at the time. When Grace grew up, she continued to draw her cheerful cherebes.

In the mid-1940's, the kids disappeared from the Campbell ads. They were missed by 40% of today's population. Surveys indicate that many people still connect the Campbell Kids with Lee Ann Gunderson of 116 Olcott Dr. Lee Ann is actively engaged in free-lance writing and merchandising work through a New York agency called "The Merchandising Group." She is at present playing food editors with a soup luncheon to promote the return of the Campbell kids and, of course, the product they represent.

Soup is one of the most widely used foods in the world. The word comes from the Latin "suppa" and to us from the Old French, "soupe." My parents and grandparents always had homemade soup before the evening meal. That, and a good crisp salad with a variety of vegetables, were considered essential.

I make my own soup stock. There is nothing like good bone marrow stock to revive a cold or virus sufferer. While the recipes for most soups call for water, I believe the secret of really good soup is in the stock. A combination of stock and water. If your beef stock is weak in color, as sometimes happens, add a can of commercial consommé, undiluted.

Do you know, the soup serves a similar purpose to that of hors d'oeuvres? The heat and moisture of the soup stimulates the salivary glands and the flow of gastric juices. Frankly, when I have soup, I can't eat anything else. Last night, we had homemade onion soup baked in crock in the oven. I used Diane Lucas' recipe from the Cordon Bleu Cook Book, which I have altered slightly.

Two local women, Naomi Peck and Gloria Weiss, have good onion soup recipes. Naomi's is in the 1970 Herald cookbook.

Soups a l'ognon (Onion Soup) 4 to 6 tablespoons onion, 6 medium sliced onions, 1/2 cup sliced celery, salt and pepper to taste 1/2 teaspoon French mustard 1/2 cup dry white wine 2 1/2 cups beef stock or water Gruyere, mozzarella cheese

grated Parmesan cheese sliced, toasted French bread Melt butter in casserole. Add onions, salt, pepper and mustard. Brown slowly to a very dark brown over a medium fire for approximately 30 minutes. Add flour and stir until smooth. Continue stirring while adding wine and stock or water, until you bring it slowly to a boil. Draw aside, drop temperature and simmer for 25 minutes.

Four into individual serving crocks. Top with sliced toasted bread, slice of Gruyere or mozzarella stop bread, then with grated cheese. Bake until top is bubbly and golden brown.

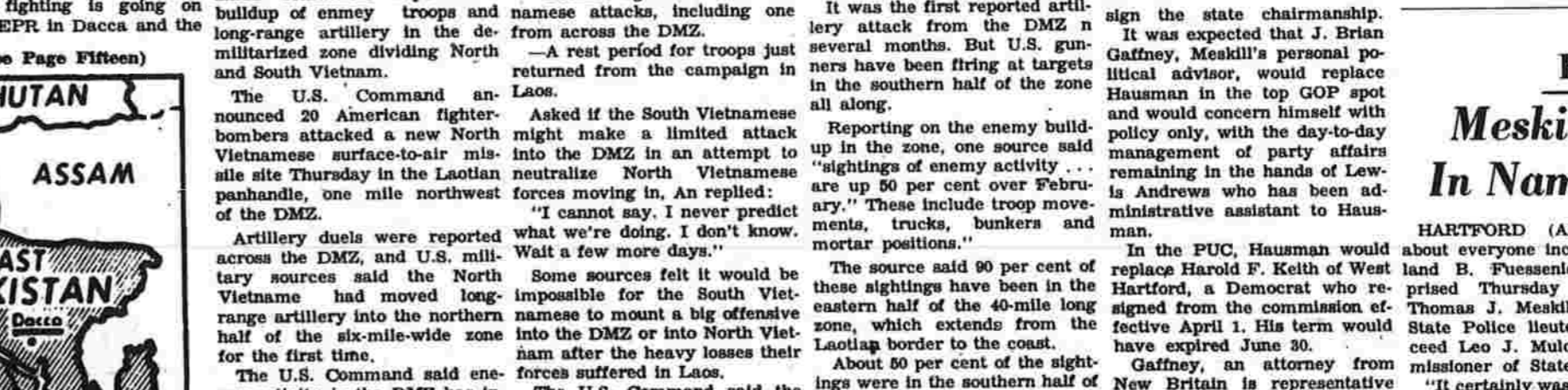
