Beginning of Boy Scouts Dates Back to Boer War

BRANFORD, South Africa (AP) — One of the last of the original Boy Scouts recalled how it all began as the movement held its 13th World Jamboree in Japan recently.

The Boy Scouts were inspired by a crew of fearless young messengers at the siege of Mafeking, one of the celebrated episodes in the Boer War.

"There were 26 of us when it all began," says Linden Bradford Webster. "And now I think I am the last living messenger of the Mafeking Messenger Corps."

Webster, 88, is a retired gold miner. He was living with his family at Mafeking, a frontier town and key rail junction, during the turn of the century where his father was a shopkeeper.

The two were stopped on a routine motor vehicle check, Vernon police said. Both were held in lieu of \$1,000 bond.

"Colonel Baden-Powell mustered every male over 16 to help with the defense of the town. He found he was without messengers and orderlies.

"In November besieged Mafeking was relieved. Baden-Powell called all the fit town boys together and the cadets were reformed. We were called the Mafeking Messenger Corps."

The boys, all between 12 and 18 were divided into teams. Webster says and allocated to various defense positions.

"We were dispatch runners. I was allocated to Baden-Powell's headquarters."

The messenger corps became famous, not only for its courageous service under fire, but for the inspiration they later

Diamond-Producing Trade Encounters Rough Time

KIMBERLEY, South Africa (AP) — The business of producing diamonds is going through its roughest time in a long time. The last world-wide diamond sales conference, which took place in London last month, was a disaster.

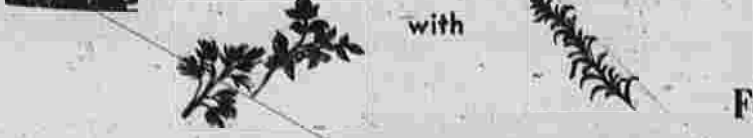

Tortoise Fighting for Survival

Mike Klemens' five leopard tortoises devour their three-weekly meal of lettuce and other vegetables from a local grocery store. The five leopards go through nearly 40 pounds of the supermarket scraps a week, and it isn't unusual for one tortoise to eat two heads of lettuce.

Although most turtles die young through accidents or human ignorance, they can live in their natural environment. Turtles and tortoises are generally considered to be the longest lifespan of any animal known to man.

There are several good books on turtles and tortoises, but there is still a tremendous lack of information, according to Mike. There are few people around who know much about the reptiles, and Mike learns mainly through experience.

With the help of Dr. Allan Levantthal, a Bolton veterinarian, Mike has been treating some of his turtles for fungal diseases. They get periodic injections in the rear and already some improvement has been noted.

There is one rare species of turtle found in Connecticut—the Minkley turtle. Similar to the wood turtle, it is semi-aquatic and lives mostly in swamps. But they're almost extinct—only three were found in the state this year.
