





# South Windsor ADM Grant Explained By Sprenkel

At the Town Council meeting last night, Town Manager Terry Sprenkel clarified the amount of money the town will receive under the additional annual Daily Membership (ADM) grant outline by Gov. Thomas Meskill.

Sprenkel said the town can expect an additional \$35,444.50 which represents an increase of one-third of the block grant provision and one-third of the remaining \$10,000 earlier based on the \$200 amount instead of the \$120 passed by the General Assembly. The town had hoped to receive \$100,000.

However, the council last year did not include the additional income in its budget. Mayor Abraham Glasman said, therefore, the town was not caught short.

This year it has made adjustments in the budget to receive a \$210 ADM grant per pupil since this amount was already approved, Sprenkel said.

Sprenkel also commented on the effect of the manufacturers' inventory and merchants' and traders inventory tax legislation which results in a lower level of the annual Grant List for South Windsor.

He said that the State Statute provides for a reduction in the manufacturers tax at the rate of 10 per cent per year until the tax is eliminated on the local level and the M&T is based on one-tenth of the base year.

He said the town used the full assessed value, without required reductions, South Windsor's list this year would have increased \$4,025,000 on the 1972 Grant List, Sprenkel said. He also noted that had these assessments been available, the Grant List would be approximately an increase of \$7,000,000 as opposed to the \$3,812,000 reported.

Sprenkel further added that had the assessed value been available, the town would receive \$228,442 this year but are instead receiving grants in lieu of tax amounting to \$18,000, the difference being \$210,442.

Sprenkel said he was calling the attention of the council to the fact that the town is at the rate of decrease will continue to increase (this year's inventory is based on 50 per cent loss) until such tax bases are completely eliminated under the present legislation.

He also noted that figures of depreciation are based on the 1965 inventory list not on the current, adding that this should be something you (council) will want to remember as the towns and cities will feel the loss impact worse and worse in years to come."
