## Secret Peace Talks Resumed In Paris

PARIS (AP) - Henry A. Kissinger resumed his secret amid indications that their governments are determined to seek a quick settlement.
The chief obstacle appeared to be the South Vietnamese government's insistent demand for withdrawal of all
North Vietnamese troops from South Vietnam. But Kissinger gave no indication how strongly he would insist on this point.

## Peron Seizes Initiative
