this time of the year there was a lot of mail, and just a penny seal on a letter or package would help him in his plan. The first Christmas seal was used in 1904. The money was used to build a children's tuberculosis hospital in Denmark.
A woman named Miss Emily Bissel of Delaware, liked the Christmas seal idea and worked very hard to get it started in this country. In 1907, the first stamps went on sale in Wilmington, Delaware. stamps went on sale in Wilis blon, Delaware. Your mother and father have probably already been ent some seals through the mail. Today, money from the sale of Christmas seals helps fight air pollution and many lung diseases
