## Animal of the Week: The Whale



The biggest animal that ever lived is the whale. The largest type is the blue whale. It can be nearly 100 feet long and can weigh nearly 150 tons. Whales are mammals. The babies are born alive and drink their mother's milk. Whales have very poor sight, but they can hear very well. They sleep by floating on the surface for several minutes at a time. Thousands of whales have been killed for food, oil and other products. The United States has declared whales to be an endangered animal and will not let any whaling products into the country.


## A Mini Page "How Do You Do?"

How do you do paper weaving?
What you'll need
2 sheets $12 \times 18$ inch construction paper Scissors


1. Fold a piece of construction paper the long way.

2. Mark off a line across the top open edge.

3. Cut lines as shown. Stop at marked edge.

4. Fold the other sheet of paper the long way and cut strips two at a time
5. Open up the large sheet and weave strips in and out. No paste is needed if strips are woven tightly
