Miss Jarvis also started the custom of wearing carnations on Mother's Day. The carnation was her mother's favorite flower. At first everybody wore a white carnation. Then people started wearing a red flower if their mother were living, and a white flower if she were dead.
The first national Mother's Day was proclaimed by President Wilson in 1915. It is observed the second Sunday in May.
