## The Indian Teacher Sequoyah

Sequoyah was the son of a white father and an Indian mother. His English name was George Guess.

Sequoyah invented a way of writing for the Cherokees. His first student was his six-year-old daughter. He later taught the Cherokee Indians to read and write in their own language. For the first time, Indians could write letters and keep records. Sequoyah also wrote about the history of his people.

The great Sequoia trees in California were named for him. He lived from 1760 to 1843.
