It's like one big musical melting pot It's like one big musical melting pot!" What's the difference between rock and
jazz? Rock has a more definite beat that is repeated over and over again. Jazz has more variety. The main difference is that with jazz, you play anyway you want to. Although yo

studied it and can play other kinds of music as well.
Jazz is changing all the time, but under

## Super Musician: Miles Davis

Miles Davis is a famous jazz musician who plays the trumpet. He was born in 1926, in Illinois, but grew up in East St. Louis, Missouri. His father was a dentist. Davis started playing the trumpet when he was 13. After finishing highschool, he studied at the famousJuilliard School of Music in New York. He is known as a real improviser. He became famous when he organized a band in 1948 and began making records.
