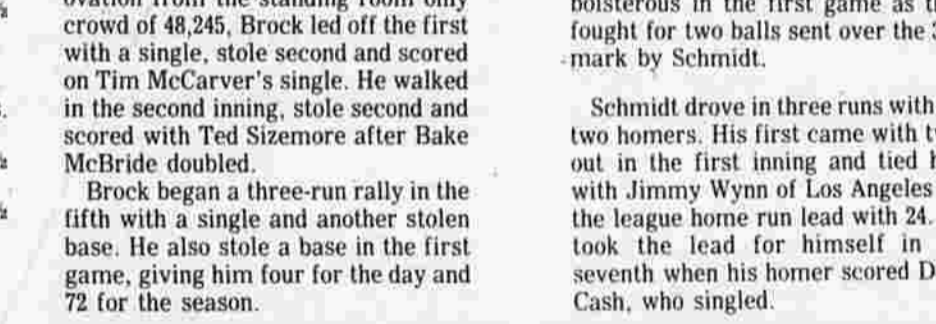

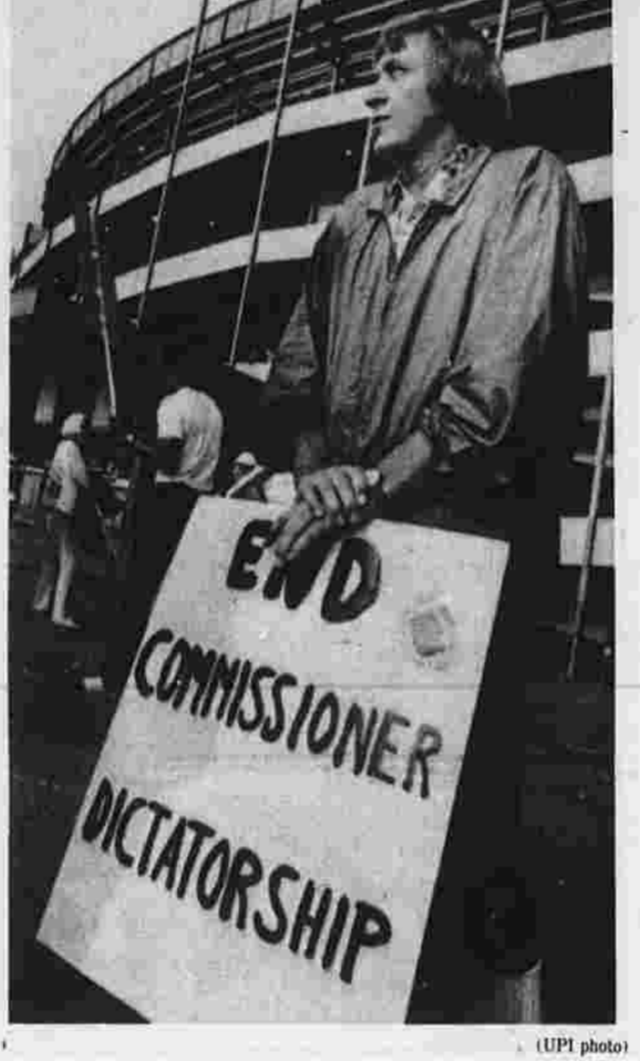

Care enough to write the hospital administrator, Edward Kenney of Manchester Memorial Hospital, or don't you want to know...

I'll bet you don't know how long there has been a part-time chaplain at Manchester Memorial Hospital. Who supports the chaplain financially? Who is the present chaplain? What does the chaplain do in the hospital? Is there a chapel service in the hospital on Sunday morning? Can you ask the chaplain to visit someone who is having an operation? Will the chaplain talk with families of patients? Do you know how many beds are usually filled at the Manchester Memorial Hospital? Do you know what it would cost to have a full-time chaplain available to our hospital? Do you think it would be worth it to patients and their families?

That's the questions — here are answers.
The chaplaincy started in 1961. During the last 13 years, eight chaplains have served our community hospital. The names of Robert Giuliano, Theodore Batchelor, Eugene Mace, Tolly Williamson, Henry Millan, Carleton Young, Howard Pope and Jean Gilbert are well known to some of us elderly pastors.
Chaplain Gilbert works 20 hours each week in our hospital. She conducts a Sunday worship service at 8:30 a.m. in the chapel. Her main task is to visit "unburied" patients and also see as many new patients who come from out-of-town as possible. She counsels with patients and families as much as time allows. She is paid \$4,000 from the hospital and \$2,000 from the MACC.

It could be very helpful to patients and families to have well trained full-time chaplains available in the hospital. It would also be helpful to the churches of the area to have a trained and training chaplain available. But it would be most helpful to the staff of the hospital if we have such a professional available in their midst. It would probably cost about \$14,000 to hire and house such a professional person.

Many of us just get acquainted with the chaplain when they move on to other persons in 13 years. I believe that hospital, community and patients would benefit from a state chaplaincy present to us for several years. The time may be near to push for action. Do you

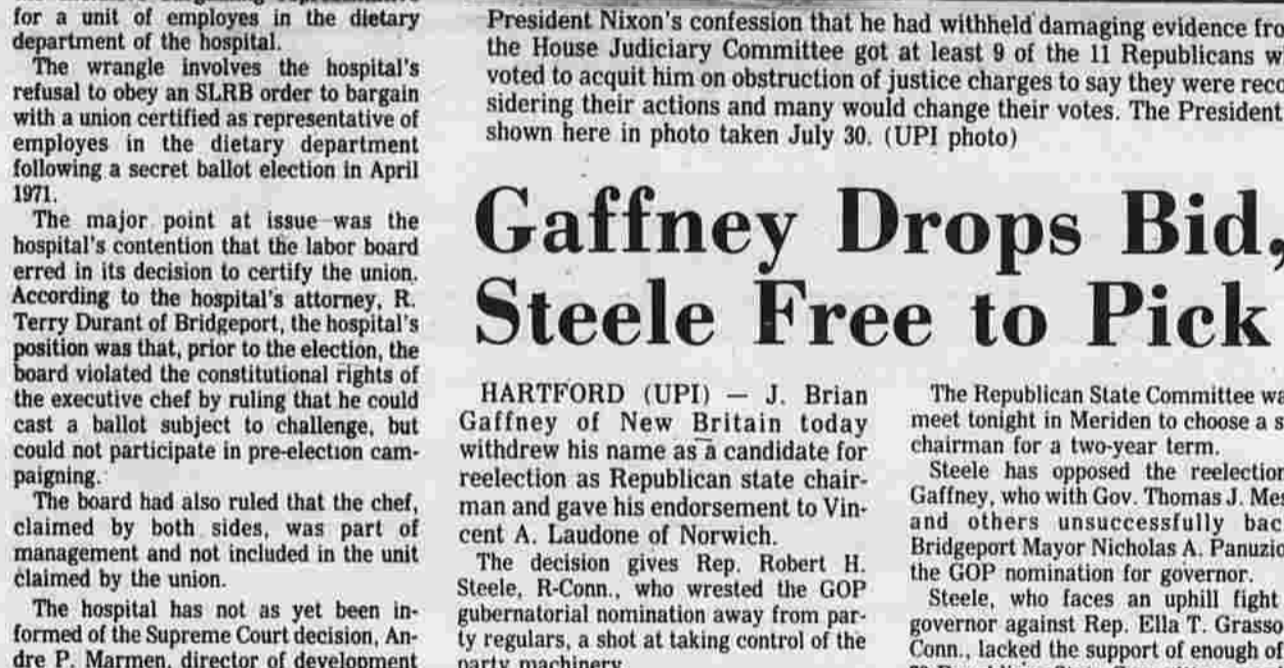

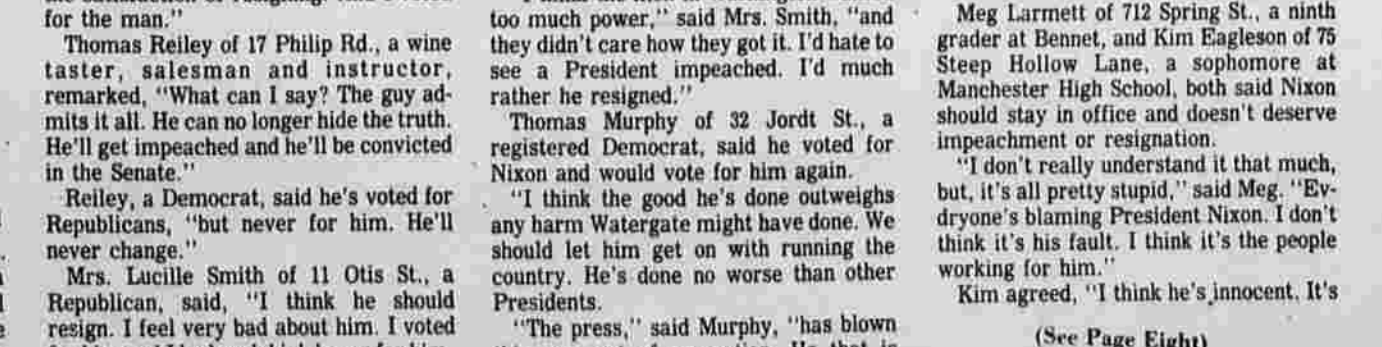
