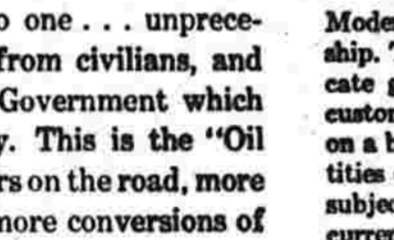

Will Raise Funds For Rebuilding

New Haven, Nov. 13.—Secretary of Commerce W. Averell Harriman announced today the opening of a campaign to raise \$100,000 to reconstruct war-damaged buildings at Yale-China which is now conducting some of its classes out of doors.

Harriman is head of a general committee of 66 Yale Alumni seeking funds for the school at Chang-sha, which was extensively damaged by Japanese invaders.

Henry E. Lane, magazine publisher, heads the campaign committee, according to the 41st Yale-China annual report issued here by Executive Secretary W. Reginald Wheeler the Changsha institution, serving 1,300 students and operating a 250-bed hospital, needs six new buildings besides repairs to buildings burned and looted by the Japanese.

words to the tenants in changing the method of allotting priorities when sales are made. Boggini says that he has been announced some time ago that when the homes were sold, the choice would go to veterans in the projects, then to other residents in the projects. Now Boggini says the preference goes to World War I veterans from any place in the country, leaving World War I veterans and other project residents out of the picture.

Many tenants, Boggini says, relying on the first promise of the PHA, figured that when sales day came they would buy their homes, and made no provision for themselves elsewhere. Now they find that they are to be "dumped out" by the sale. However, Boggini points out that there is a clause in the sales terms in that any present tenant may remain in his rent for a year from the sales date.

Residents of Orford Village, as in all other federal projects throughout the state, are anxiously awaiting action by the federal court in New Haven Monday. At that time the Public Housing Administration is expected to answer attorneys for project residents who have requested an injunction to prevent sale of their homes. Last week in federal court, residents of the Plainville project, whose rented homes now are being sold, brought legal action to compel the cessation of the sale by the governmental agency. At that time the court granted the PHA one week to prepare an answer to the petition for an injunction. The Plainville first selection of homes was held on Monday, but a grave emergency would result in the town where over 200 people would be turned out of their homes. Similar situations are regarded as likely elsewhere in the state if the general sales program continues. For this reason project residents, banded together to make the Plainville situation a test case, and on the court's decision in the matter is said to rest the tenacity of the PHA.
