### Court Finding Views Labor Law Repealed

Legislation Restricting Issuance of Injunctions Ruled Voiding Another Statute  
Hartford, June 16.—A state law restricting the issuance of injunctions in labor disputes repealed, in effect, another statute providing for the continuance of temporary injunctions pending appeals, the state supreme court ruled today.

Supreme Court Also Orders New Trial in Case of Car's Driver  
Hartford, June 16.—The state supreme court, reversing a superior court decision, today ordered damages paid to three passengers in an automobile which crashed in a traffic control station in Waterbury. The accident occurred at night, during a heavy rain.

in the case of the passengers, and in ordering a new trial for Delahunt, the supreme court said the jury could reasonably have found that:

"This station was an unusual obstruction. The city placed and maintained it to improve on local motorist frequently using the intersection that a car colliding with it would be damaged, and no driver could reasonably be expected to avoid it."

The jury's award of damages to the passengers was set aside by the presiding judge, John A. Cornell. The jury found for the defendant in the city of Waterbury, in Delahunt's case.

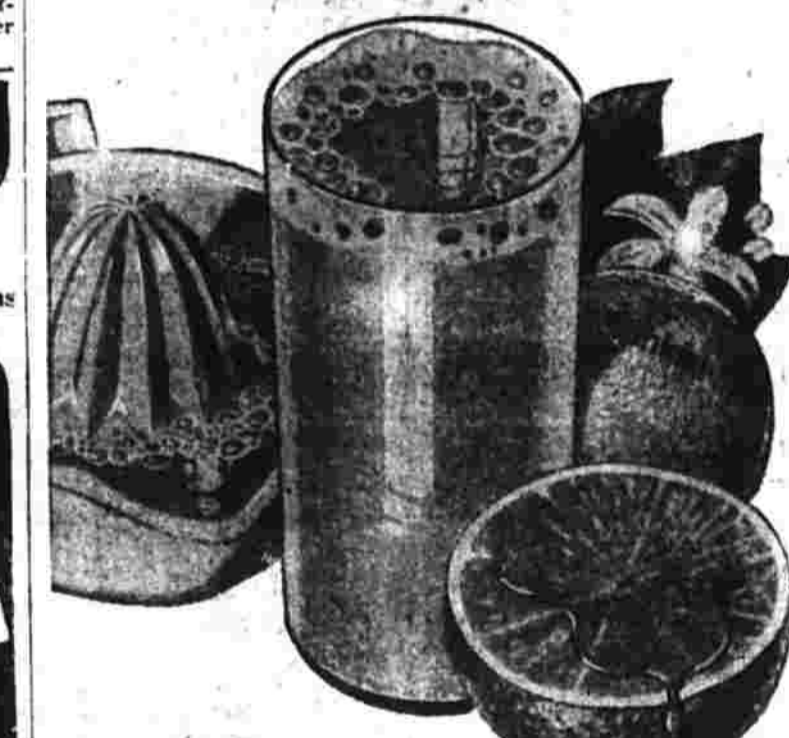
