

Vernon Resuscitator Money Drive Seen Twice Amount Needed

Manch., July 30 (Special)—As a result of last night's house-to-house canvass, Vernon Freeman now has more than twice the amount of money needed to purchase an electronic resuscitator in memory of his late son, Robert Blaisdell.

A total of \$1,266.75 in cash was collected last night, bringing the Blaisdell Fund to a current total of \$1,588.50, fund chairman Kenneth Raschbach said today.

Cost of the resuscitator the firm, The District now may use the extra money for a second resuscitator for electric convulsers for the three fire trucks, or for other needed equipment, Raschbach said.

Fund leaders will discuss the matter with Mr. and Mrs. Robert Blaisdell before they decide how to spend the additional money, Raschbach added.

The resuscitator fund is named after the Blaisdell 2-year-old son of Robert Blaisdell, Jr., who drowned in the Hookanun River behind his Okebrook Heights home June 20.

The final total collected for the Blaisdell Fund is twice to the credit of the fund, Raschbach said. The fund is now \$1,588.50, he said.

Many promises to contribute were received last night but have not been included in the reported total, he said.

Mr. and Mrs. Blaisdell and their helpers will get out again tonight to canvass for the fund, he said.

Among the possible uses for the money collected in excess of \$1,000, Raschbach indicated, a second resuscitator might be the most worthwhile. One machine could be kept in Palmettoville and the other in Vernon Center, he said. One was carried out of town there would still be one on hand should a second emergency arise, he pointed out.

But the fund chairman also mentioned that the firm has been hoping to purchase electric convulsers—costing about \$120 each—for each of the three fire trucks. The money could well be used to purchase this equipment, he said.

DON'T HURRY TO TAKE AN ACE

One way to test your bridge-playing friends is to show them today's hand. Ask them to play the South hand at four spades against a heart opening lead.

The average bridge player will grab dummy's ace of hearts and will then look around for a trick to conquer. If so, you can be ready to offer sympathy; the hand is already lost.

It doesn't matter what South does next. He may lead another heart, or he may lead trumps, or he may lead clubs. In any case, West can take the ace of spades to remove dummy's trump, and then take the ace of clubs to defeat the contract.

This dummy game can be avoided if South refuses the trick. A simple play, but one that very few players see at first glance.

Now the defense is helpless. If they lead trumps, South keeps right on with the trumps. Dummy will still take the hearts with the ace, and South can draw trumps and return to the diamonds.
