## **Prize for Case Brothers**

As reported in the April 30, 1881 *Hartford Courant*, there were honors for American manufacturers at the Melbourne International Exhibition in Australia.

In papers, the eleven American exhibits receive 8 first and 3 second awards—of these two are from Connecticut, Peter Adams of the Waverly mills, Buckland, and Case Brothers of South Manchester, each receiving a first.
