Schuetz Body Not Claimed
Wife Asks Only to Bury Children in Philadelphia Tragedy

Philadelphia, Jan. 5.—The bodies of four children of Mrs. Margaret Schuetz were taken to the Greenfield, Mass., home of her mother, Mrs. M. Schuetz, to be buried there today.

Chief Coroner received instructions from Mrs. Schuetz to send the bodies of the children, ranging from nine months to two years of age, to Greenfield.

Both said an effort was being made to reach Schuetz's relatives in Manchester, Conn., to arrange for the bodies.

One of three notes left by Schuetz's father here in Manchester, Conn., was being given to Temple hospital for anatomical studies, and the other scattered "off Hartford" (Conn.) to his own home in New York City.

No plan is being made at the hospital to cremate the bodies, it was stated. It was stated that arrangements should be made for the Philadelphia authorities.

State Guard members and citizen volunteers were called to the scene. The Palestine area was struck at 8:30 p.m. sixty miles to the west of Houston.
