House to Ponder Loan To Britain Next Week
Important Part of Government's Post War Plans Will End Practices Hurting Trade

Seen Fine Senate Candidate
Hartford, June 27—(AP) Dr. James L. McConaughy, former Republican lieutenant governor, said yesterday U. S. Rep. Clara Booth Luce (R., Conn.) would make a fine candidate for the United States Senate.

World Mean Better Business Better Uncle would mean better business for the United States since it would mean bigger markets to which to sell American goods.

She can't borrow all of it after that date, if she hasn't borrowed all of it by then. The money, if partly borrowed will be called the principal of the loan.

That will give her 50 years—or until 2001—to pay back. The yearly payments including amortization and a few pennies for interest principal will be \$120,000,000.

That interest rate—less than 2 per cent—is less than Britain would have to pay if she tried to borrow the \$3,750,000,000.

It is about the same interest rate the government will have to pay when it borrows the \$3,750,000,000 in order to make the loan to Britain.

The tax money the government takes in every year from American citizens isn't large enough to pay all the government's expenses. This extra expense, the loan, therefore will have to be borrowed.

But the interest rate will be sure to be more than the loan rate. The interest rate will be 5 per cent.

Not says Fred M. Vinson, now chief justice of the Supreme court but secretary of the Treasury when the loan agreement was worked out with Britain. But he says:

"I call it more than a loan. I say it is a contract, and I think we get benefits, at least in judgment, greatly in excess of the amount of money we provide for them."

The congressional committee, in effect, said the same thing. By being of course, they were thinking of improved American trade when Britain in line with the agreement, changes her trade methods and gives us a bigger and freer market.

Why does Britain need the loan? She needs the dollars in the next few years to pay for the food and materials which the British people will need.

Need Dollars To Do Buying The British figure they will have to spend dollars in the next few years between \$5,000,000,000 and \$6,000,000,000 more than they can sell abroad. To do that buying they need dollars. Why?

They probably could not pay for all they need to buy abroad with their own currency, pounds sterling. Other countries are loaded down with pounds sterling because of what they sold to England during the war when Britain was trying to save her dollars for buying other things she needed in this country.

Langer Victorious In North Dakota
 Fargo, N. D., June 27—(AP) North Dakota, traditionally a state of decisive returns, revealed today that the state's voters nominated Langer (R., N. D.), one of the two U. S. senators who voted against the nation joining U. N., while repudiating for the second time in as many years former Senator Gerald P. Nye, one of the nation's most outspoken isolationists.

Langer continued to pile up his victories after 35 years service, with a record of 100 per cent in the Senate. The latter conceded Langer's victory when the count from 1,844 of the state's 2,256 precincts gave Langer 27,210 and Nye 48,091.

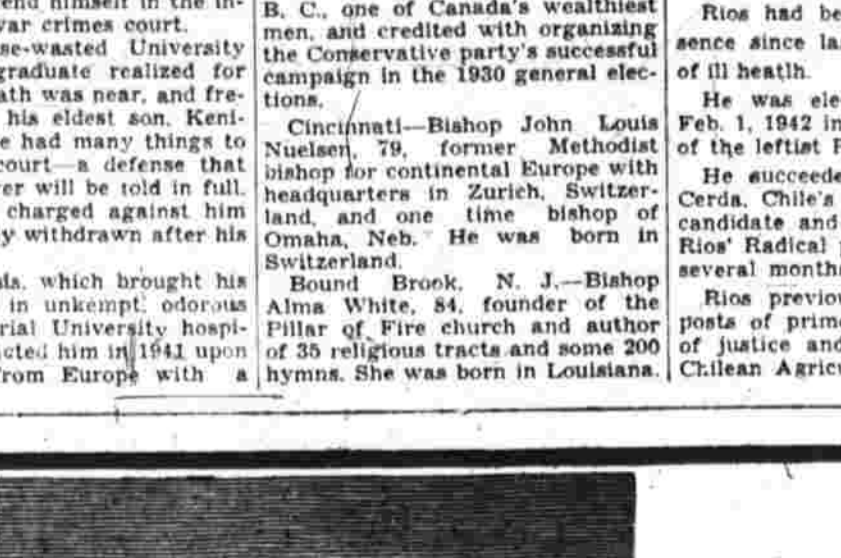
Chilean President Taken by Death
Santiago, Chile, June 27—(AP) Juan Antonio Rios, president of Chile since 1942, died here after a prolonged illness. He was 58 years old.

He was elected president on Feb. 1, 1942 in a sweeping victory of the leftist Popular Front.

He succeeded Pedro Aguirre Cerda, Chile's first Popular Front candidate and fellow-member of Rios' Radical party who had died several months earlier.

Rios previously had held the post of prime minister, minister of justice and president of the Chilean Agricultural bank.

Army Places Its War Dead and Missing at 308,978

Washington, June 27—The first consolidated listing of Army dead and missing in World War II—a compilation of the names of nearly 310,000 men and women who gave their lives in the Nation's service—was released today by the War Department.

The list was made up of fifty booklets, one for each state, one for the District of Columbia, and one for the Territories and Possessions of the United States. Each booklet contained a forward explanatory of the methods of listing, a breakdown by counties and types of casualty, and an alphabetical listing by county of the names of individual men and women who met their death. The Philippine Commonwealth was included in the study.

An overall death and missing rate of 2.8 per cent from all causes was indicated by the listing. Of more than 10,000,000 men and women mobilized into the Army between 1941 and 1945, the listing showed that 308,978 were killed in action, 194,141 were missing or became missing, later to be determined dead. The suits are based on charges that the companies had conspired to collect a total of \$9,043,500 in treble damages. The alleged violations of the antitrust laws were committed between August 1, 1945, and August 31, 1945.
