Federal Court to Retain Bill of Complaint For Present
Hartford, Aug. 3.—Judge J. Joseph Smith of the U. S. District court today in a memorandum of decision denied the motion for temporary injunction sought by the striking Niles-Benjamin CIO union to restrain state and local authorities from "interfering" with their rights in the case of the Hidden Grove.

The court said it will for the present retain the bill of complaint by the union, pending determination by the state courts and on whether the injunction covering the Hidden Grove is within the scope and constitutionality of the national law of Connecticut relating to the peace as applied to such pickets.

At issue was the limiting of the number of pickets at the gates of the home on home picketing, the ban on home picketing, the ban on picketing at the plant, and alleged interference with distribution of leaflets.
