### Talbot Raps Strid Taken by Mitchell

Waterbury, Sept. 5.—(AP)—Rep. Joseph E. Talbot (R-Conn.) today declared that Harold A. Mitchell, state chairman of the Republican Central committee, had "chosen to violate the basic obligations and responsibilities of his office."

Talbot is a candidate for the nomination. Mitchell's statement cannot believe that the delegates will permit themselves to be deprived of the very function for which they were elected by conscientious citizens in their own communities. Representative Talbot declared.

"As of Robbery" The Soviet minister called the act of Talbot by which Italy obtained Trieste in the First World War as "an act of robbery." Talbot was not yet ready for a Russian declaration of the kind which he was making.

Considerable importance attached to the Soviet stand on the issue of Trieste because thus far, the Russian delegation has neither failed to support the Soviet line in its demands for the treaty clauses agreed upon by the Big Four.

While Italy claimed that "internationalizing Trieste" was a "threat to world peace," Yugoslavia was demanding the whole of the peninsula, including the port, and the Big Four apparently last night were at odds.
