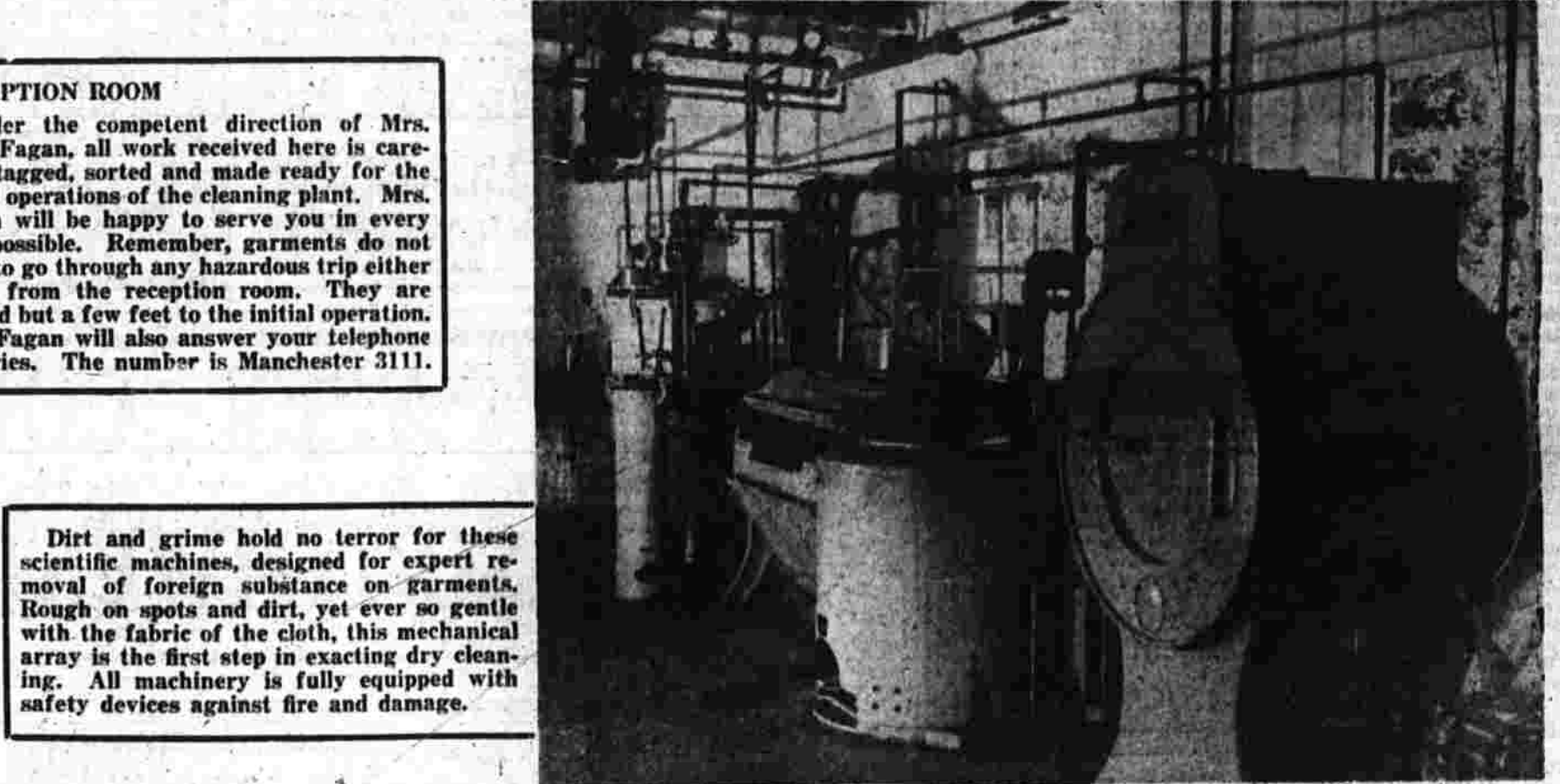

Hadden Backs State Bonus

Proposes Early Court
Opinion on Constitu-
tionality Be Sought

Hartford, Sept. 6.—(Special)—Attorney General William L. Hadden says that he, personally, favors payment of a state bonus to World War II veterans, and has proposed that an early court opinion on the constitutionality of such a payment be sought.

Hadden's proposed method, and favored amending the constitution immediately.

"I don't think the Republican party can get away with that answer (Hadden's proposal), he said. 'We know it is an amendment passed the bonus is valid. We don't need the legal niceties we have had this afternoon.'"

Opposition to a bonus came from Harold C. Bailey of West Hartford, a World War I veteran who said he didn't think "the Republican party wants to get into the vote buying business."

Other planks proposed by various individuals and organizations for the platform to be presented to the Republican convention next week included more pay for teachers, a 40-hour week for state employees, repeal of the state tax on towns, establishment of a fair employment practices commission, old age assistance payments increase, reconstruction of county jail, a state-wide adult probation system and election, rather than appointment, of municipal court judges.

Favors Early Initiation
Stating that "my opinion cannot clear up the situation; only the (State) Supreme court can do that," Hadden told the committee that the General Assembly should initiate bonus legislation early in its session next January.

Then he proposed a "proper state official" come before the Supreme court for a determination of its constitutionality.

The enabling act could be passed in January, the suit could be filed in February, and by the end of March we could reasonably expect a decision," Hadden said.

It is unconstitutional, then a constitutional amendment could be initiated. If it is constitutional, then the Legislature can proceed to work out a bonus law right away.

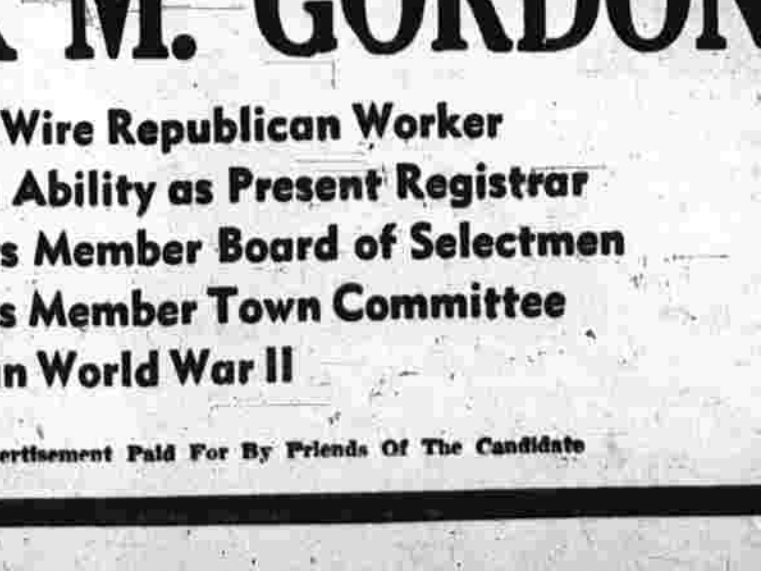

Father of 11 Held in Death

Lowell Bricklayer Will Face Charge of Murder in Slaying

Lowell, Mass., Sept. 6—(AP)—Rosario A. Milanazzo, 56, a Lowell bricklayer and father of 11 children, was booked on a charge of murder today in the slaying of Mrs. Catherine Nordlie, 36, mother of three children, whose bullet-riddled and battered body was found dangling from a sewer outlet in the Merrimack river a week ago.

The woman disappeared July 21 after having supper at the home of a Lowell sister. Her body was discovered by two fishermen.

Questioned for Two Hours Milanazzo was booked after two hours' questioning by District Attorney George E. Thompson of Middlesex county and local and state police. Officers Andrew Chabing, who was assigned to guard Milanazzo after he had been booked and he fell asleep directly after he had been placed in a cell.

The woman's body bore three bullet holes in the neck, and evidence that she had been beaten on the head. Police theorized that the body had been stuffed in a sewer about a mile from the outlet in which it was discovered.

They said that heavy rains apparently washed the body of the feeble worker through the city ditches to the river.

Milanazzo was questioned shortly after the body was discovered but was released later. He was taken to police headquarters again late last night and subjected to another questioning by Thompson. Sgt. of Lowell Police Michael H. Winn, Mike Detlevics James F. Coniff and Joseph Crescio and Lieut. Edward Laton of the Lowell police.

Winn said that Milanazzo had been friendly with the woman who was separated from her husband, reported Mother Missing.
