OPA Set to Boost Price Of Sugar, Decontrol Items

Washington, Sept. 11.—The OPA, getting set to boost sugar prices, granted an 18 per cent hike for window glass today and simultaneously wiped out all ceilings on razor blades, baby carriages, fountain pens and more than 20 other commodities.

Reports of the coming sugar price boost were confirmed by Secretary of Agriculture Clinton P. Anderson who said at Albuquerque the increase will be announced in a day or two.

Under terms of the contract between the Cuban government and the community credit corporation, the price paid for Cuban raw sugar must climb to correspond with rises in the cost of living in this country. Such an increase now is due and will be reflected also on sugar from other sources.

A job lot of consumer goods ranging from toilet sets to dry batteries, were removed from price control today. OPA said some were "in the cost of living."

Other items were in good supply and hence no longer in price restraint.

The controls, it is noted, are for razors, safety razors, razor blades and razors, except electric razors; baby carriages, strollers and carriages; dry batteries; fountain pens and mechanical pencils and pens, as well as pens and pencils; buckles, fasteners and clasps; but not shoe fasteners; portable air conditioning equipment; under one horse power; hand lawn mowers; hand insecticide sprays and dusters.

Also, floor coverings, mats, rugs, and carpets, cut, etched, engraved and sand-blasted glassware; furniture made wholly or mostly of plastics; television sets in combination with radio sets; televisions already been decontrolled; nursery pads for high chairs; play table; handkerchiefs; trunks, suitcases and feather trunks; insignias, emblems and ornaments.

Says Problem Of Palestine Is World Wide

(Continued from Page One) He declared that the Arab states had their rights recognized and that the part of Palestine which would be set off to make a home for Jewish refugees would be a home for a body of immigrants belonging to different nationalities.

"Palestine has been required to be the instrument in the realization of the dreams and ambitions of political Zionists. Thus a heavy burden has been laid upon her shoulders, and a policy imposed upon her which seems to deprive that Jew people should be finally uprooted from their own land and placed in another people's land."

Jewish Agency officials, meanwhile, were drafting a reply to the Arab document's latest contribution in which the organization was accused of "ignoring the plight of European Jewry."

The reply, informed sources said, would indicate the agency's intention to discuss only Jewish statehood with Britain and would point out that Jewish leaders intended to remain in London to be available for any informal talks the government might care to initiate as a preliminary to full-scale Jewish participation in the conference.

Communications also were being exchanged by the Arab delegations with representatives of the Palestine Arabs higher executive. One Arab source said that if the higher committee's executive met the Grand Mufti of Jerusalem, it was possible they subsequently would send representatives to the London conference, at least as observers.

Serve Notices On Squatters

Over 1,000 Barricaded In Apartment House In Greater London

London, Sept. 11.—A process server in black coat and striped trousers climbed through a ground floor window of Duchess of Bedford house today and served an eviction notice on 1,000 squatters barricaded in the building, a luxury apartment block in London's fashionable west end.

Stanley Henderson, secretary of the squatters' committee and a leader of the Communist-sponsored movement to commander tenanted dwellings, said he had been summoned to appear in court next Tuesday.

"It is between us and the ministry of works he added. I don't fully understand it. I am now going to get legal advice."

The squatters had posted sentries behind barred doors to resist eviction efforts of the labor government.

Court action to evict squatters also was taken at Birmingham, where Sam Blackwell, secretary of the Midlands District Communist party said "we will fight the squatters case to the last ditch."

The seven-story Duchess of Bedford house, in a secluded section of gentile Kensington, was vacant when the squatters moved in as a "direct action" move in the British housing shortage.

Similar siege conditions were developing at the 25 or so other tenanted buildings which squatters seized in widely separated areas of Greater London.

The Duchess of Bedford house, privately owned but leased by the government, was the headquarters. A scattering of spectators stood across the street from the building from which only a single child emerged to walk to his guardian in a nearby park.

"It's revolution, nothing else," said property lawyer James H. order—never thought I should see it in England."

When two government employees reached the house seeking to remove furniture, they were met with admission by a sentry who shouted "nobody gets in or out. One government man said he was threatened with an iron bar."

Bill Carritt, a Communist official, told reporters.
