Effective Control Of Atomic Energy Seen as Possible

Scientists of United Nations Atomic Energy Commission Make Report; To Be Submitted to Political Group Next Week

Lake Success, N. Y., Sept. 26.—(AP)—Scientists of the United Nations Atomic Energy commission declared today that effective control of atomic energy, which the world is seeking to harness for peace, is possible on the basis of available scientific facts.

Report Adopted Unanimously The finding was made in a 22-page report adopted unanimously Thursday by the scientists who make up the commission's Scientific and Technical Advisory Group. The report will be submitted to the commission's Committee on Atomic Energy at its next meeting (10:30 a. m., Sept. 27).

Having discharged the task assigned by the political group, the scientists said, "Whether or not it is politically feasible is not discussed or implied in this report. It is a technical recommendation of the particular system or systems by which effective control can be achieved."

The report was the first international finding on atomic energy to be approved unanimously and was adopted by the commission's political group in a 12-0 vote. The report was the result of a conference held in Lake Success, N. Y., Sept. 26-27.

Meat Shortage Seen Easing After Month; Price Curbs Helpful

Baker Says Improved Supplies in Beef and Pork Beginning Later Part of October; Expects Fall Runs of Cattle and Hogs to Market Will Get Under Way Soon

Washington, Sept. 26.—(AP)—The Baker deputy OPA administrator, predicted today the meat shortage will begin to ease up in two to four weeks. At the same time, he contended that price control on meat "does not reduce the supply" during this period of scarcity, but actually increases it.

Reasons to Expect Better Supplies Baker said in a radio address (ABC network) that "there is good reason to expect improved supplies of both beef and pork beginning with the latter part of October."

Price Control on Meat Does Not Reduce Total Supply Baker said that price control on meat does not reduce the total supply that will be available to consumers until the end of the shortage period.
