Seven Persons Killed In Fire at Refinery; 140 Others Injured

Thunderous Explosions Continue Seven Hours Before Subiding Early Today; Blasts Felt 20 Miles Away in Philadelphia; Fire Sweeps Unchecked for Four Hours After Ignition

Marcus Hook, Pa., Oct. 4.—(AP)—Seven persons were killed and upwards of 140 others injured by fire and thunderous explosions which roared through a unit of Sun Oil Company's \$13,000,000 aviation gasoline refinery seven hours before subsiding early today.

\$200,000 Damage Estimated Sun Vice President Arthur E. Fow, Jr., estimated damage to the refinery at \$200,000.

Flames from the refinery were seen from Philadelphia, 20 miles away.

Many of the injured were volunteer firemen. The heaviest casualty toll occurred when flames, racing out of a pump along a 12-foot, fractionating tower, lit up with a roar, the shock rocking the country for miles.

Many in Critical Condition All of the deaths occurred in the refinery and in nearby hospitals. Many others of the 60 admitted to hospitals were reported in critical condition.
