2-Year Old Tot Killed When Run Over by Bus

James G. Benson, of 5 Tyler Circle, Dies Instantly; Wandered into Road at Station

James Gordon Benson, two-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. James Benson, of 5 Tyler Circle, was instantly killed at 8:30 this morning when he was crushed by a five-ton bus operated by John Wilcox of 19 Locust street.

The youngster was playing in the vicinity of the regular grocery at the corner of Hartford road and Wadwell road when he was making his way to the bus stop.

Two eye witness accounts of the tragedy were secured from the York Street station. One witness, Mr. Edgar A. Holt or Mr. Holt, who lives at 111 Wadwell road, said that the Benson youngster had been playing in the yard from the neighborhood a few minutes before the accident.

The second witness, Mrs. Holt, who was driving the bus, said that she was making a right turn when she was playing with the light and marker lights on the bus.

It is assumed that the youth was killed before the driver stopped to give the pocketbook back to the owner. There were no cries and neither Wilcox nor any of the passengers noticed any bump.
