guarding arms control by an international inspection system as a result of the idea that if adopted would result not only in a constant watch over armaments of all nations but also put an end to secret treaties of kind, which took the initiative in demanding an arms cut, has considered various inspection proposals as applied to atomic energy alone, there was some hope evident among the diplomats gathered here that a formula might be worked out which would be acceptable to both America and Russia and result in concrete proposals for bringing all types of armaments under strict control.
Other Developments
As the arms cut program demands for action against Franco Spain, the veto question and more than 50 other issues moved into a new phase of assembly work, passing from the general debate to consideration by committees. There were these other developments on hand or in prospect:
1. The United States delegation expected to receive soon instructions from Washington on the American government's policies for putting mandate Pacific islands captured from Japan under U. N. trusteeship.
The war and Navy departments had favored keeping some strategic islands, such as Okinawa, under the American flag. The State department had wanted to subject all of them, at least nominally, to the United Nations. A decision by President Truman had awaited agreement among Secretaries Byrnes, Patterson and Forrestal. There were apparently reliable reports that this decision has now been made.
Awaiting Bevin's Arrival
The British delegation was awaiting the arrival of Foreign Secretary Ernest Bevin, en route here for the Foreign Ministers' conference opening Monday, to determine its exact policy on a variety of problems. Chief among these is the British attitude toward the Russian and American proposals for having the United Nations get reports on strength and location of all troops stationed in foreign countries.
3. Russia, Czechoslovakia and Yugoslavia have rejected a request by the United Nations that they attend a special conference to consider internationalizing traffic on the Danube river. This request was apparently rejected. The United States, Britain and Greece accepted an American initiative approved.

Local Price Control Units Close Nov. 4

61 District Offices Will Be Kept Running to Control Ceilings Still Left in Effect
By James Marlow
Washington, Nov. 1.—(AP)—On Nov. 4 OPA closes its 1,642 local price control boards. But—this does not mean the end of OPA now.
There'll still be some price ceilings—To control them, OPA will keep 61 district offices running.
Best Ceilings to Stand
And retail ceilings stand, unchanged. OPA will keep its 600 area rent control offices running to set on rents.
But from now on keeping the lid on retail prices—the prices which you the consumer pay—will be left together.
By this action—scrapping 1,642 local price boards and dumping the whole load of retail price control on 61 district offices—OPA is greatly weakened.
Better Chance for Consumers
For that reason, consumers will have a far better chance to spy out the bad price control.
Here's the score:
1. The items which remain under price control still are scarce. Some of them—like refrigerators and washing machines—are listed below.
2. If—after Nov. 4—you think ceiling is being violated, you'll have to complain to your nearest OPA district office.
3. You'll have to apply to that same district office if you want information—about rents, for example.
4. If you have a complaint—or want information—about rents, for example, you'll have to apply to that same district office.
5. If you lost your sugar ration coupon, tell it to your nearest OPA district office.
Decision Pretty Sudden
OPA's decision to register the local boards was pretty sudden. It was part of the job of finally ending OPA's price control.
OPA said that once the ceilings were taken off meat and other foods, the local boards became unnecessary because the worst shade was over.
Here are some of the items which the public will find still under price ceilings. If you have doubts about the prices on them, get in touch with your nearest OPA district office.
The list includes:
Building materials and lumber.
Meat (cattle and hogs).
(Clothing should have on it a retail ceiling price tag attached by the retailer or manufacturer).
Most heavy consumer durable goods such as household electric refrigerators, washing machines, electric ranges, vacuum cleaners, cooking and heating stoves, floor coverings, and bed-cleaning goods like springs and mattresses.
Some of the items of household furniture.
(Again, most of the furniture is supposed to have ceiling tags).
Farm machinery and equipment.
Some of it is supposed to be tagged with price ceilings. But the district offices have a complete list.
Automobiles, most automobiles.

Zion Lutheran Sermon Topic

Pastor Prokopy to Deliver Address on Reformation Sunday
Reformation festival will be celebrated Sunday, designated as Reformation Sunday, at Zion Evangelical Lutheran church, 28, Cooper and High streets, during its regular service at 10 a.m. The service will be ushered in with a procession by members of the Sunday School, singing the well-known Battle Hymn of the Reformation, "A Mighty Fortress Is Our God," the word and music of which were composed by Martin Luther himself.
Pastor Prokopy, describing the reformer writes:
October 31, 1517 is considered Reformation Day, when Dr. Martin Luther nailed 95 theses or propositions on the door of the Castle Church in Wittenberg, according to a custom of posting matters for academic discussion. These were a sincere protest against the abuses of the papacy and the indulgences which were sold by the church. The publication of these theses spread quickly and widely and became the beginning of the reformation or purification of the Church. For years such a reformation was felt necessary. As far back as 1415 the Council of Constance had been convened to consider reforming the church in head and members.
In his sermon Sunday, the pastor, the Rev. Paul G. Prokopy, will give the essential background of the Reformation, stress the fundamental principles on which it is based, "sola scriptura," the Bible alone, and "sola gratia," the Bible alone, and will point to some of the blessings and the application of them. He will preach on "The Reformation and Luther," based on two important passages for which Luther contended, Luke 10:28, and Romans 3:28. Luther brought writing hymns for the people in 1528, leading to the publication of a hymnal of eight hymns, four of which he wrote. It has been called the spring from which sprang the large stream of Protestant hymns. No Christian hymn has been translated into more languages and dialects than "A Mighty Fortress is Our God." Extolled by Carlyle and many others, it has given courage and comfort to many.
For the Reformation service Sunday, the parents of the Sunday School children which will take part have been especially invited. A cordial welcome is extended especially to those who have no church home.
